Playoff Rules

Last Revised: April 2026

All Regular Season rules apply, except for those listed below:

1. All games will be seven (7) full innings with no time limit. Any cancelled or partial games due to inclement weather will follow Rule #1 of the regular season rules.
2. The team that finishes higher in the regular season standings will be designated as the HOME TEAM for the playoff game and the lower regular season standing team shall be designed as the VISITING TEAM
3. No game can end in a tie.

Tiebreaker (Softball Canada): starting the top of the 8th inning and each half inning thereafter, the offensive team shall begin its turn at bat, with the player who was the last at bat from the previous inning, being placed on second base. In the case where the last at bat is an injured player, runner will be the 2nd last better.

4. Teams who need to secure a replacement pitcher must inform the opposing captain before the start of the game. If both Captains are not in agreement, the Executive is to be contacted to make a decision.
5. This spare usage count resets for the playoffs and a team cannot use the same spare more than three (3) times during the playoffs, regardless of the position they are called in to play.
6. Winning Captains must provide scoresheets to the playoff committee.
