



Glen Cairn Ladies' Softball League (GCLSL)
Tournament Rules for May Tournament

Last Revised: April 2026

All Regular Season rules apply, except for those listed below:

1. All round robin games will be six (6) full innings, with no time limit. All championship games will be seven (7) innings. Any cancelled or partial games due to inclement weather will follow Rule 1.3 of the regular season rules.
2. During round-robin games, the home team will be decided by a coin flip by the umpire. For championship games, the home team will be the team that is the highest in the standings after the round-robin games. In the case of a tie, the home team in the championship games will be decided by a coin flip by the umpire.
3. A maximum of FIVE (5) runs can be scored per team in a single half-inning for innings 1 thru 5. Once 5 runs cross the plate, the half-inning ends immediately, even if fewer than 3 outs have been recorded. There is no run limit in the 6th inning/last declared inning or any extra innings.
4. For the Championship Game, a maximum of FIVE (5) runs can be scored per team in a single half-inning for innings 1 thru 6. Once 5 runs cross the plate, the half-inning ends immediately, even if fewer than 3 outs have been recorded. There is no run limit in the 7th inning/last declared inning or any extra innings.
5. Team standings for the championship round will be determined by the tournament committee as follows, in this order:
 - a) Winning record
 - Teams are awarded points for any win or tie in the round-robin games.
 - Win (2 points), Tie (1 point), Loss (0 points)
 - b) Game scores
 - The winning team in the round-robin game is awarded points for the number of runs they win by, to a maximum of +7 points.
 - The losing team receives a negative point for every run they lose by, to a maximum of -7 points.

b) If two or more teams are tied in the standings after a) and b) are calculated, the standings will be determined as follows, in order.

- Head to Head
- Best total net score (total runs for, less total runs against)
- Least runs scored against

6. Winning Captains must provide scoresheets to the Tournament Committee.
