

ARTICLE XV LEGAL STATUS PROVISIONS

SECTION 1500: CONFLICT WITH OTHER LAWS

In their interpretation and application, the provisions of this Ordinance shall be held to be minimum requirements. Wherever the requirements of this Ordinance are at variance with the requirements of any other lawfully adopted rules, regulations, ordinances, deed restrictions, or covenants, the more restrictive or that imposing higher standards shall govern.

SECTION 1501: SEPARABILITY AND ABROGATION

Should any article, section, subsection, paragraph, clause, or phrase of this ordinance, as amended from time to time, be declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid for any reason, such decision shall not invalidate the Ordinance as a whole, nor any other article, section, subsection, paragraph, clause, phrase, or part thereof, other than the specific part so declared to be invalid.

SECTION 1502: REPEAL OF CONFLICTING ORDINANCES

Upon the adoption of this Ordinance, all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict with herewith are hereby repealed to the extent necessary to give this Ordinance full force and effect.
