

## A note from your Vestry and The Junior Warden

As we wind down what basically has been well over a year of identifying needs, getting quotes, coordinating contractors and following up, we would like to share with you our completed list of projects, both big and small:

Upgraded and rewired our Wifi to enable uninterrupted livestream service. Purchased 4 new router extenders. (donated) Purchased three livestream cameras, stands and brackets. (2 donated)

Performed electrical inspections to ensure the safety of our Church and Parish. Removed exposed, energized, electrical wires around the time clock. Replaced defective and dangerous electrical wiring in the Narthex and Nave. Replaced 2 defective outlets in the Nave

Installed 4 new outlets to eliminate the use of extension cords around the holidays.

Installed new hose bib on the left side of the church to allow cleaning and maintenance of the landscaping.

Installed new architectural roof system designed to simulate slate. 50 yr manufacturers warranty, 10 year installation warranty

Installed all new flat roofing system over Neville Hall, Kitchen, Sunday School and the bell tower (2 roofs)

Painted the church inside and out. Created the Sherwin Williams color (St Paul's White) for the interior.

Repaired (still in progress) damaged stain glass windows #2,#5,#10, the 12 over the choir, and 1 in the bell tower. Repaired the framework around the St Paul window over the alter. Cleaned, painted trim and protected all other windows including the bell tower.

The final tally is still out, but all of this and some smaller repairs planned for the rectory will cost around \$225,000.00. If we are wise with ongoing maintenance and keep up with minor repairs, our beautiful church should be good for well into the foreseeable future. The vestry voted to borrow from our endowment to finance these projects and to allow for a complete renovation at one time. Our intention is and always has been to replace those funds with donations and if necessary fund raisers.

To date, we have received around \$50,000.00 in donations. We are ever so grateful for those that have given, but we still have a long way to go. If you haven't had a chance to donate, and are in a position to, we are reaching out now to ask. If you have donated, but can possibly afford to give a little more, we really would appreciate that too. Below, we have some recommended donation levels, but any amount you can give helps!
