Dear Parish Family:

I did not expect to be writing an Advent/Christmas Newsletter article to you, but surprise! I am going to be at St. Paul's for a while longer. It is a long story and the information will be shared in another mailing that the Wardens and I are planning for the near future. But it was important to send you the Advent information now, since by the time you get this, Advent will have already begun.

I was recently on retreat with the Oratory of the Good Shepherd. During that retreat I began thinking about the connection of the unexpectedness of my current situation and the unexpectedness in the stories we remember during this time of the year. Certainly it was unexpected to the Blessed Virgin Mary to have an angel show up one day and tell her that she had be chosen by God to give birth to His Son. It was unexpected to Elizabeth when Mary arrived for a visit and to have her baby (John the Baptist) leap in her womb at Mary's greeting. It was also unexpected that towards the end of her pregnancy that Mary and Joseph would have to leave the comfort of their home to travel to Bethlehem because of a census.

I came to the conclusion that there are so many unexpected things in life. The real test for us is how we are going to react. I find that I first react by "freezing" – my mind needs to take in the unexpected. But once I live with it for a little while, I begin to think about how it is that I will change my plans or thinking to accommodate the unexpected.

Perhaps you can think about how it is that you react to the unexpected in life and remember that the very event that we are preparing celebrate (although it was foretold in scripture) was unexpected by the world.

# **Christmas Boxes for Hope4 Recovery**


