#### THE MICHIGAN CYBERPATRIOT PROGRAM



Since the 2015 academic year, the regional coalition of schools known as the Midwest Colloquium for Information Systems Security Education (MCISSE) has been dedicated to increasing the number of middle and high school students who participate in the National Youth CyberPatriot Competition

through funding from Michigan CyberPatriot Program. The Michigan CyberPatriot Program provides hands-on STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math) education for Michigan students and opens the doors to a STEM career pathway in information technology. Far too many local school districts and student groups across Michigan have yet to be made aware of this program and its advantages. With over 450,000 cybersecurity jobs unfilled nationally, it is imperative for Michigan to attract more students into STEM education programs and STEM careers.

## The Michigan CyberPatriot Program

The Michigan CyberPatriot Program serves the state of Michigan - from the Ohio border to the Upper Peninsula. Its purpose is to inspire students toward careers in cybersecurity, information technology, and engineering disciplines critical to our nation's future and national security. The Michigan CyberPatriot Program has grown from 4 teams and 20 students in 2015 to over 180 teams with more than 950 students. These Michigan students compete nationally in the fastest-growing cybersecurity middle and high school competition in the world.

In addition to competing in national youth competitions, the Michigan CyberPatriot Program hosts summer cybersecurity camps across the state with elementary, middle, and high school students, using resources from a coalition of higher education facilities and volunteers. Michigan's ability to compete in these national youth competitions is made possible through the generous sponsorships and volunteerism that are obtained each year from the state's business, industry, academia, and other non-profit organizations.

#### Supporting the Michigan CyberPatriot Program - Three Ways

1. Become a strong supporter and annual financial sponsor for all facets of the Michigan CyberPatriot Program.

Funding is required to help pay for CyberPatriot engagement activities (e.g., team competitions, camps, and the Annual State CyberPatriot Student Award Spring Celebration) and the cyber education platform during the school year. Historically, the Michigan CyberPatriot Program has received:

- \$20,000 in 2017 from the Michigan Economic Development Corporation.
- \$100,000 in 2018 from the Michigan Department of Education.
- \$37,000 in 2019 from general sponsorships,
- We've had a dramatic decrease in contributions since the COVID-19 pandemic.
- 2. **Become a volunteer coach, technical mentor, or team assistant,** as these are critical to the Michigan CyberPatriot program's success.

Volunteers do not have to be cyber experts. Still, they should have basic computer operations and systems knowledge, be passionate about teaching or mentoring middle or high school students, and be committed to ethically teaching cybersecurity.

#### 3. Become an advocate for the Michigan CyberPatriot Program.

Work with Michigan's chapter of MCISSE to recruit more Michigan youth teams by helping to identify Michigan schools and youth organizations that might be interested in participating in the Michigan CyberPatriot Program. Promote and encourage using the CyberPatriot Elementary School Cyber Education Initiative (ESCEI) in schools and youth organizations to directly engage educators, administrators, community leaders, parents, and students interested in improving STEM and cybersecurity education in Michigan.
