"I'm really hungry" — Her First Words After a Major Win

When Lydia Ko won her first major at the 2015 Evian Championship at just 18 years old, everyone expected a tearful speech. Instead, she smiled and simply said:

"I'm really hungry."

The room burst into laughter. It was the most relatable and humble answer a newly crowned major champion could give. That quote went viral and became one of Lydia's signature moments.



Meditation, K-pop & Staying Chill

While some golfers hype themselves up with rock music and coffee, Lydia's pre-round ritual is quite the opposite.

She practices mindful breathing, meditation, and listens to her favorite K-pop artists like BTS to get into the zone.

"I don't want to get too hyped. I want to feel balanced and calm before I tee off."

In her golf bag, she even carries a small notebook with self-reminders like: "You're doing great — just swing free."

Knitting Between Rounds? Yes, Really!

While many players spend their downtime scrolling through social media or sightseeing, Lydia Ko has a unique hobby: knitting.

She once shared a photo of a pink beanie she was working on between tournament rounds, sparking surprise and admiration from She said fans. knitting helps her stay calm and focused - and yes, she's gifted hand-knit scarves to friends and coaches.

"World No.1... but Still Can't Drive"

After becoming the youngestever World No.1 at just 17, Lydia joked in interviews:


"I can't even drive myself to the golf course. My parents still have to drop me off."

Despite being the best female golfer in the world, she was still doing homework and helping with chores at home. She often said that staying grounded was what helped her stay sharp on the course.

The Quiet Queen Who Broke Every Boundary



She wasn't loud. She wasn't flashy.

But quietly and steadily, she became one of the most dominant golfers in history.

She didn't chase headlines, but with one groundbreaking decision—to play in a men's PGA Tour event—she forever changed the landscape of women's golf.

She is Annika Sörenstam, the legendary Swede known simply as the "Queen of Golf."

Annika wasn't born a star. As a child, she was shy, introverted—even purposely playing poorly to avoid giving speeches on the winner's podium. Yet this quiet girl from Sweden went on to dominate the LPGA Tour for more than a decade.

With 72 LPGA Tour victories, 10 major championships, and eight Player of the Year awards, she built a career that rivals any golfer in history. In 2001, she made history by shooting a 59 in competition—the lowest round ever recorded in a women's professional event—earning her the nickname "Miss 59."

In 2003, Annika shocked the golf world by accepting a sponsor's exemption to play in the PGA Tour's Colonial Tournament, becoming the first woman in 58 years to tee it up in a men's event.

The backlash was swift. Critics accused her of seeking attention. Some PGA players openly disapproved.

But Annika responded with calm confidence:
"I'm not trying to prove that I can beat the men.
I'm trying to prove that women deserve to be here."

Though she didn't make the cut, she shot 71 and 74—respectable scores under immense pressure—and proved that her place on the world stage was well-earned. That single tournament brought unprecedented visibility and respect to women's golf.

Annika retired from professional golf in 2008, but her impact only grew. She founded the Annika Foundation, focusing on the development of young golfersespecially girls through tournaments, education. and leadership programs. She's hosted youth events across the globe, championing the idea that athletics and academics can go hand-in-hand. mission is clear:

"I may not always win on the course, but I want to keep winning for the next generation off the course." Annika is one of the greatest female golfers of all time. But her legacy isn't just about records or trophies—it's about redefining what's possible for women in sports. Her story reminds us:

Winning isn't just about beating others—it's about breaking limits.

Bravery doesn't always roar. Sometimes, it's calm, quiet, and unstoppable.

她不张扬、不喧哗,却悄悄地,赢得了历史上最多的女子高尔夫冠军之一。

她不争议、不炒作,却用一次跨界出战男子PGA赛事的决定,改变了整个女子高坛的未来。

她是Annika Sörenstam, 来自瑞典的传奇,也被誉 为"高尔夫皇后"。 Annika并不是天生的"球场明星"。小时候她性格内向,不爱说话,甚至因为胆小曾故意打出高分避免领奖台发言。但就是这样一个害羞的女孩,在1990年代和2000年代的LPGA赛场上展开了长达十年的统治。

她共赢得72场LPGA赛事、10项大满贯,8次被评为"年度最佳球员",几乎包揽所有能拿的奖项。2001年,她在比赛中打出历史性的59杆,成为至今唯一一位在正式比赛中打出59的女子球员——从此被尊称为"Miss 59"。

2003年,Annika做出了一个震惊世界的决定——她宣布将以外卡身份参加男子PGA巡回赛的殖民地邀请赛。

那是58年来首位女 性在男子PGA正式 赛事中亮相。

质疑如潮水般袭来。有人说她"作秀",有人说她"打不过男选手",甚至有男球员在媒体前公开表达不满。

但Annika只淡淡地回应:"我不是为了证明女人可以赢男人,我是为了证明我们可以站在同一个发球台上。"

最终她虽然未晋级,但她在强大压力下打出了71杆和74杆,证明了自己的竞技水准,

也为女子高尔夫赢 得前所未有的曝光 和尊重。 Annika在2008年正式 退役,但她从未离开 这项运动。她成立了 Annika Foundation, 致力于青少年、特别 是女孩在高尔夫中的 成长与教育。

她主办了多个青少年 赛事、学术和领导力 活动,鼓励"学术+体 育"双发展模式,亲自 辅导下一代球员。她 常说:

"我不会永远在球场上 赢球,但我希望永远 在球场之外,推动更 多女孩去赢她们的人 生。" Annika是历史上最伟大的女子高尔夫球员之一,但她的真正意义,在于她打破了"女性只能在女性舞台上闪光"的界限,在沉默与稳健中重新定义了"冠军"二字。

她的故事告诉我们:

胜利不只是击败 对手,而是突破自 己;

勇敢不一定要大 声,但必须坚定。

A Round in the Newport Breeze

At 7 a.m., the sun was still gentle, and the air along the coast felt as crisp and clear as freshly brewed cold brew. As I pulled my golf bag along, I took a deep breath—the scent of the grass at Newport Beach Country Club mixed with the salty breeze from the Pacific. It smelled like summer.

This course is beautiful—so beautiful it almost feels unreal. Every hole looks like it was taken from a designer's sketchbook. The fairways are trimmed like carpets, and on either side, palms and California oaks sway gently in the wind. Standing on the first tee, the elegant clubhouse behind me with its white walls and red tile roof, and a sunlit slope ahead brushed by ocean breeze-I didn't rush to hit the ball. I just wanted to freeze that moment.



By the 5th hole—a coastal par 4 perched above the harbor—I paused to line up my shot. Just then, a seagull skimmed past, as if to carry the wind's direction for me. I struck the ball; it flew straight and true, catching the sunlight like a fleeting thought, then landed softly on the edge of the green. In my head, I quietly hummed a line from California Dreamin'.

The greens at Newport roll fast and true—not unforgiving, but never easy. "It's not as brutal as Pebble Beach," my caddie said, "but don't expect it to be friendly either." I laughed, telling him that's exactly like Newport itself—graceful, with personality, and never in a hurry.

After finishing 18 holes, I sat on the clubhouse terrace with an iced Americano. The sun cast a slant of light over my cap, and I watched a small white ball still being gently tapped toward the cup in the distance. I thought to myself: the magic of golf is that there's always a reason to come back.

青少年高尔夫专栏

从兴趣到突破:青少年高尔夫 训练全路径指南

第一节 | 青少年训练计划: 分年龄阶段打造专属路径高尔夫是一项"慢热"的运动,但正因如此,它更适合从小培养。不同年龄阶段的青少年球员,身体发育、心理成熟度、理解能力都不同,因此"分龄训练"已成为近年来高水平青训的关键策略。

5-8岁: 玩中学,培养兴趣这一阶段的训练重点在于"玩"。教练通过游戏化教学,比如"小怪兽切杆"、"推球进动物之家",让孩子对高尔夫产生天然的兴趣。挥杆动作不追求标准,而是鼓励模仿与探索。"多尝试、多体验",让孩子在笑声中建立身体与球杆的初步连结。

教练建议:使用轻质球杆、 颜色鲜艳的球具,更容易引导 小朋友注意力。 9-12岁:动作扎根,初试比赛此阶段孩子的协调性和理解能力显著提高,可以进入"技术启蒙"阶段。教练会带领他们建立挥杆基础动作,如正确握杆、姿势调整、力量分配等。同时,孩子们可参与友谊赛、小型分龄赛事,学习在规则与时间限制下完成比赛。

小建议:记录每场训练表现, 建立"成长日志",让孩子自己看到 进步。

13-17岁:技术提升与心理建设并重

这是高尔夫发展的黄金期,也是 竞技梦想发芽的阶段。球员需接 受系统性的挥杆纠正、短杆专项 训练与球场策略教学。同时心理 素质也至关重要——如何在压力下 保持专注、如何走出一杆失误的 阴影,这些都是通往职业或高校 高尔夫之路的必修课。

多数大学教练在此阶段开始观察潜力球员,家长和教练应关注孩子的GPA和比赛记录同步提升。



Junior Golf Spotlight

From Curiosity to Confidence: A Complete Guide to Junior Golf Development

Part 1 | Training Pathways by Age: Building the Right Foundation

Golf is a sport of precision and patience—and that makes it ideal to start young. But not all young golfers should be trained the same way. Every age group has different physical, mental, and emotional needs. Here's how top junior programs are now approaching golf development stage-by-stage:

Ages 5-8: Learning Through Play

At this age, the primary focus is fun and discovery. Coaches use games like "Monster Chipping" or "Animal House Putting" to help kids engage with the game. Swing form is not forced; imitation and exploration are encouraged. The key is to spark curiosity and create a positive first impression of golf.

Pro Tip: Use lightweight, colorful equipment to hold attention and build confidence early.

Ages 9-12: Laying Technical Foundations

Children at this stage have better coordination and are ready to start learning golf's fundamentals—grip, posture, swing plane, and basic shot types. They also begin to understand rules and etiquette. Small tournaments or scrimmage events are introduced to teach time management and on-course awareness.

Tip: Start a "golf journal" for kids to track progress, reflect on lessons, and celebrate milestones.





Part 2 | Parent's Corner: How to Be a Supportive Partner in the Journey

Behind every rising young golfer, there's often a parent—or team of parents—who strike just the right balance. Not pushy. Not detached. Supportive in the ways that matter most.

1. Respect the pace, not just the outcome

Golf is a marathon, not a sprint. Development includes plateaus and setbacks. Parents who support steady growth rather than demanding fast results help build long-term resilience.

2. Encourage effort, not just trophies

After a round, don't ask "Did you win?" Instead try:

"You stayed calm on the 9th hole—that was impressive."

Or: "You're getting more consistent with your putting."

These observations celebrate progress, not iust outcomes.

3. Partner with coaches, don't hover over them

Be proactive in understanding your child's training and building trust with their coach. The best junior golf environments form a "triangle" of collaboration: coach, parent, and player.

4. Support life outside golf

Encourage friendships, school involvement, and hobbies. A well-rounded lifestyle contributes to mental health and on-course confidence. Golf should enhance life, not consume it.
