I have been a full-time faculty member at Shasta College since 2017. Before coming to Shasta College, I taught college courses in microbiology, genetics, and molecular biology at UCLA and Cypress College and high school at Fairmont Preparatory Academy in Anaheim, CA.

Robert joined my class during when Microbiology sections were running as hybrid courses, with lectures being online and asynchronous and labs being in person. The asynchronous lecture required students to establish their own schedule at an appropriate pace to stay on track with the coursework. Despite some health issues early in the semester, he kept up with the work online and did extra work for the labs he missed so he would not fall behind. He had insightful questions that showed he was thinking deeply about the material and striving to fully understand it, rather than just aiming for points. In the lab, Robert developed his skill as an organized and thorough microbiologist. At the end of the semester, he demonstrated great technical skill with the techniques he learned throughout the semester, applying them to identify a "mystery microbe" in our capstone project for lab. His work was well organized, clearly presented, and concisely explained. Although he did not correctly identify the microbe due to one mistake with a somewhat finicky test, he showcased his overall understanding of the concepts and techniques and the report reflected his overall experience and achievement in the course. Robert is an enthusiastic scientist who worked with care and precision in performing lab activities. He was meticulous and thorough, always making sure he understood all the steps involved in an experiment before beginning the work. There characteristics helped him succeed throughout the semester. Robert was a thoughtful and kind lab partner as well, always contributing equally to shared work and doing extra work when his lab partner was absent. When his lab partner stopped attending lab near the end of the semester, he showed resilience and adaptability by continuing to do excellent work on his own and collaborating with other lab groups seamlessly when needed. His successes can be directly attributed to his acumen, discipline, excellent time management, careful attention to detail, and tireless pursuit of fully understanding the material.
