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SATAN AND LGBTQ+

Today many are confused by all the language about “sexual identification.” Satan uses confusion and blurring the line between truth and lie in an attempt at defeating Christians and making the Bible seem obsolete. He uses the TV, internet, newspapers, and Hollywood to blur truth in the area of sexuality.

If you have seen the letters and symbol LGBTQ+ you might wonder what that means. It stands for some of the over 50 so-called sexual identities, specifically lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender, queer (unlimited), self-questioning and the “+” stands for even more.

We are to ***“Be self-controlled and alert. Your enemy the devil prowls around like a roaring lion***

looking for someone to devour. Resist him standing firm in the faith, because you know that your bothers throughout the world are undergoing the same kind of sufferings,” 1 Peter 5:8-9. As it pertains to our subject if we changed the last word from “sufferings” to “confusion” and it would still be true.

I can't help but think that those who are engaged in this confusion know it's a lie. But love for darkness rather than light (John 3:19) is why they promote it. I have lived long enough to know there are haters of the Bible, the Church, and of Christ, and they love to mock all three. This “gender thing” is just another way to do that.

Our response should be to (1) Love the truth as recorded in the Scriptures. (2) Love those who endorse this sin with the love described in 1 Cor. 13, without approving of the sin. (3) Have no fear of speaking the truth in love. Wrong is wrong regardless of how many think otherwise and even if it has fooled a loved one. (4) Realize that a mind that has been influenced by perversion still needs to be treated with respect for them...not the sin.

Being repulsed is natural as a Christian's first reaction to this sexual identity lie. It even causes a feeling of disgust or nausea. However, we can't judge a person but we certainly can and should judge the act. In fact, the acts have been judged.

God has judged those who have rejected the Word of God. *“Because of this God gave them over to shameful lusts. Even their women exchanged natural relationships for unnatural ones. In the same way the men also abandoned natural relations with women and were inflamed with lust for one another. Men committed indecent acts with other men and received in themselves the due penalty for their perversions,”* Romans 2:26-27

Those who practice sexual deviancy will not inherit the Kingdom of God, 1 Cor. 6:9ff. Jude 7 speaks of those doomed and states *“In a similar way, Sodom and Gomorrah and the surrounding towns gave themselves up to sexual immorality and perversion. They serve as an example of those who suffer the punishment of eternal fire.”*

All of this is written to encourage us not to believe the lie about sexual identity regardless of how often it is promoted and approved in print, on our TV screen, or laws written to accept it as normal. It is not normal and Satan's desire is to confuse mankind. It is sad that many have bought into it. Stand for the true...we win in the end.

TEMPTATION, A WAY OF ESCAPE

TEXT: 1 Cor. 10:1-12

INTRO: A lady illegally parked her car and left a note on the windshield that read "I have circled this block ten times looking for a parking place, so forgive us our trespasses." When she returned she found a ticket and a note that read, "I have worked this beat for twenty years and I have never shirked my duties, so lead us not into temptation."

We all have been tempted and God has never told us not to be tempted, but rather not to give into it. The Apostle Paul in our text is telling the early church of Moses and the Israelites making the journey through the wilderness and how God was not pleased with them. He warns them of the dangers of neglecting their spiritual lives and encouraged them in the matter of temptation. We can learn from it. We must "take heed" in regard to temptation, as the writer of Hebrews tells us. Here is the advice given in our text.

- I. **RECOGNIZE WE ARE NOT UNIQUE**
 - A. **WE ARE ALL SUSCEPTIBLE**
 1. "I don't want you to be ignorant" v 1
 2. We may have different temptation, but...
 3. Bible characters are not super-human
 4. We all have cravings, lusts, are boastful, etc., 1 John 2:15-16
 5. Preachers, elders, deacons, teachers, mothers, fathers, grandparents, children, in this are "all" means "all."
 - B. **SO WHAT CAN WE DO ABOUT IT?**
 1. So this: Don't give up because it is common
 2. Just know that you are not alone
 3. 1 Peter 4:12 tells us "...do not be surprised at the painful trials you are suffering as though something strange has happened."
 4. Temptation is not a sin...don't surrender
 - C. **SO HOW LONG DO I HAVE TO FIGHT IT?**
 1. For as long as you have skin (flesh)
 2. Why? Like gold, we too are tried in fire
 3. A soldier is made ready by drilling
 4. All metal must be forged...heat, heat, heat
 5. So must our faith be tested
- II. **TESTING IS GIVEN BY PERMISSION**
 - A. **SATAN HAS TO GET PERMISSION**
 1. Job 1:8 God: "*Have you considered Job?*" Devil: "*Have you not put a hedge...?*" God: "*Very well*"...you may...but no harm him the man"
 2. No matter the temptation...Satan CAN NOT, I repeat, CAN NOT harm us, he can only tempt us.
 3. We are not tempted beyond what we can endure, verse 13.
 - B. **THE DEVIL WANTS TO PROVE US UNWORTHY**
 1. He's the "accuser of the brotherhood"
 2. He desires to "sift us like wheat"
 3. He provokes as he did David 1 Chron. 21:1
- III. **A WAY OF ESCAPE**
 - A. He will "deliver us from evil" if it's our prayer
 1. 2 Peter 2:9 "...the Lord knows how to rescue godly men from trials..."
 2. 1 Thess. 5:23-24 tells us He is faithful
 - B. **YOU MUST RESIST**
 1. Resist and the Devil will flee, James 4:7
 2. We overcome evil with good, Rom. 12:21
 3. Know the rules...don't put yourself in a place where temptation hangs out, bars, strip clubs, etc.

CONCLUSION - All are tempted, God knows we can resist it and escape. The sad thing is many do not want to escape temptations but to yield...because we are drawn by our own lust. Don't blame God.

A series of studies in encouragement by Denny Coburn **Study Number One Hundred Eighteen – The Whole Person**

The rapid increase in knowledge is mind boggling. The progress made in chemistry, electronics, and medical field all of which has made it possible for space exploration that was unthinkable even in our childhood. We have split the atom, developed chemotherapy, put miniature cameras into our system to spy on our insides, put more data on a chip as small as a cornflake than there are cornflakes, gone to the moon and now even the wealthy, have taken a joy ride in space. With all of these advancements there is still one area in which we are lagging far behind in addressing and solving, the problem of maladjusted human behavior.

All “wrong” human behavior is not due to maladjustment, often it is just sin. However, there are many, way too many, who have personal problems that we have labeled but have not address as in a real meaningful way and have not cured. We have advanced in knowledge but addressing human nature from a single or perhaps from two areas rather than the triune nature of mankind, we have come up empty.

I must admit that few people are qualified to address all three natures, but there are a few. I am not one of them. However, I want to address the one area most neglected and that is the area I am most qualified to address. Let me explain. When taking a college course titled “The Elements of Logic” I was introduced to what is called a “Venn diagram.” Picture three circles that overlap and that all three overlap in one area. If one circle were to be labeled “red apples,” another labeled “sweet apples” and the third circle “Bob’s apples.” These circles each would represent only one thing about apples. But where all three overlap it would mean that Bob’s red apples are sweet. Some of his apples may not be sweet, and some may not be red, and some belong to Bob. But apples in the overlapping area are all three, Bob’s red sweet apples.

Like the apples in the diagram we must explore the triune nature of the individual. We human beings are made in the image of God are triune. We have a body, a soul and a spirit and each act on, one has an influence on the other two. The writer of Psalm 139:14 has stated, in praise to God, ***“I will praise you; for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; marvelous are your works; and that my soul knows right well.”*** The Apostle Paul wrote to the church at Thessalonica, ***“May your whole spirit, soul and body be preserved blameless at the coming of the Lord,”*** 1 Thess. 5:23. The “Venn diagram for human being is: body (physical), emotion (soul), and spiritual (the real you). People often try to shield the latter, or hide it from others as it is too “personal.”

A mother who is depressed, a teen bewildered, or a deviate father may all need to be better adjusted and all three for different reasons and causes. However, if in each case only one area of their life is addressed, or investigated, then their difficulties can’t be properly evaluated. To poke a pill down someone’s throat in an attempt to fix a physical problem when the cause may be emotion or spiritual is not a loving thing to do. We certainly do have physical problems that affect our emotion and spirit, but that is not all we are. I’m sure most of us are aware that our emotional condition may have a major effect on our bodily behavior as well as our spiritual response.

Whether one is a psychologist, psychiatrist, minister, secular counselor or simply a concerned friend, they can only and should only address the area in which they have some expertise and then refer. If one is overworked, has had a loss of sleep, or has not taken care of the body then it seems obvious that rest, sleep and hunger should be taken care of first. If the problem persists then we should refer. If you know a Christian friend has been involved in some sin and the stress of trying to keep his feet in two worlds, then his spiritual life should be addressed. I recall one man who had become involved in a sin that causes both a spiritual and emotional trauma. We are, as the Psalmist stated ***“fearfully and wonderfully made.”***

There was a time in our history that nearly all counselling was done by preachers of the Gospel. The sad thing is that in recent years preachers are referring all counselling to the secular world. Do I need to remind preachers that Psychiatrist is from the Greek “psyche” meaning soul, the area in which we preachers should have working

knowledge. Today every talk show host is a pretend analyst, psychiatrist, counselor, and healer.

It is my personal opinion, based on follow-up counseling, after a person has been treated by some secular counselors harm can and has been done to the wholeness of that person. In most cases they have dealt with only the function of the brain (emotion) and its relation the body (physical) neglecting the most valuable soul. Pills may treat some problems but certainly not all.

While it is true that we preachers/counselors are not trained, in most cases, to deal with a psychical problems it may equally be stated that those trained in that field seldom address spiritual issues. They usually do not address the subject of sin that may affect their thoughts and behavior. In fact many states make it a point that to be licensed by those states they must be schooled not to discuss “religious matters” meaning spiritual matters. For example the sin of unforgiving heart has many negative effects upon a person’s thought and behavior. The same is true of hatred, anger, lying and stealing. These are problems of the soul and should be addressed as such.

In my final years as a located preacher I did much counseling for that was the area of my Master’s Degree. I purchased a book at the drug store that listed most drugs on the market and their side-effects. I asked those who sought help from a physician or secular counselor what medication they were on and then checked the book to see what unwanted effects they were having on them so I would not be counseling drug related affects. We are to ***“live by faith, not by sight,”*** 2 Cor. 5:7 and a life lived for only the physical is a life out of balance and the secular world does not agree with that. Therefore, the world can address and relieve some problems, but good solid biblical help is essential for the whole person.

A person can be the master of what one does, but never of what one feels and being out of tune spiritually has side-effects as well as a pill. Robert Frost once stated “The best way out is always through” and this is often the only answer to spiritual problems. This is my point, we are spiritual beings and not only physical and emotional beings. God is a trinity and Genesis 1:26 states in part ***“God said, Let us make man in our image, in our likeness...”*** While Jehovah’s Witnesses say no man has a soul, the Bible disagrees.

Counseling without the Bible is like cutting a watermelon with a willow limb, it won’t go deep enough. ***“For the Word of God is living and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and the attitudes of the heart. Nothing in all creation is hidden from God’s sight. Everything is uncovered and lay bare before the eyes of him to whom we must give account,”*** Hebrews 4:12-13.

When matters of life cause us to “malfunction” we need all the help we can get. The physician is schooled in the operations of the body. The psychiatrist is schooled in the emotion (thoughts) of man. But we must remember that ***“The man without the Spirit does not accept the things that come from the Spirit of God for they are foolishness to him, and he cannot understand them because they are spiritually discerned,”*** 1 Cor. 2:14. This refers to everyone, doctors and psychiatrists as well.

When life becomes anything less than a joy, we must minister to the body, soul, and spirit of man. We can have joy in the midst of difficulty which the world knows nothing about. Why does Psalm 23 being read to a suffering soul have a calming effect? Because it ministers to the soul of man which rules the body and spirit...or at least it should.
