What Cooties Do.....

VFW's Military Order of the Cooties are known for comforting hospitalized Veterans and residents of Veteran's Homes across the Country.

“COOTIE”

The name “Cootie” is a reference to the lice that plagued soldiers in WWI, Cooties were credited with keeping soldiers heads down in the trenches.

About the Military Order of the Cootie Auxiliary


(Formerly the Women's Auxiliary to the Military Order of the Cootie)

At the MOC Scratch in 1960 the Military Order of the Cootie delegates assembled at the National Encampment. We were granted the authority to formulate plans for an Auxiliary on Pup Tent (local), Grand (State) and Supreme (National) levels. In 1961 the Supreme Auxiliary was instituted and Dorothy B. Briner (she later changed her name to Beveridge), from the Grand of Ohio, was elected as the first Supreme President. She served as Supreme President from 1961 – 1963. In 1961 the membership pin and the shield logo were designed by the MOCA and the MOCA was off and running. Subsequent Supreme Presidents authored the By-Laws and Ritual, designed the Hospital Pin, the Fun Bug, and set the Hospital goal for each member. In 1965 the MOCA became involved with the Veterans Affairs Voluntary Service (VAVS) program. The Clown program, founded in 1970, gives many hours of joy and laughter to “Keep Patients Smiling in Beds of White”.

In 1972 the Scholarship program was started and at the 1974 Supreme Convention named in memory of Supreme President Sarah Ducharme who was instrumental in its inception. Scholarships are awarded to students pursuing careers in the medical field. Each Grand may submit one new application each year. Once accepted, as long as the applicant fulfills the requirements, he or she is eligible to renew the scholarship for up to four (4) years. Over the years, thousands of dollars have been awarded to worthy students.

Each year the Supreme President chooses a Special Hospital Project. These projects have ranged from emphysema, arthritis, heart disease, cancer, spinal cord injuries, diabetes, hepatitis C, leukemia, Alzheimer's, and physical therapy to name just a few.

The VFW National Home for Children is one of the main programs supported by the MOCA. Donations for Cootie Christmas and high school graduates' scholarships are sent in each year. In addition, the supreme President, in conjunction with the National Home, picks a Special Project. These projects have included a piano for music lessons, a driver's training car, playgrounds, a green house, and donations for food and dental care.

The Hospital program, however, remains the primary program for the organization. Sisters and brothers volunteer in VA Medical Centers throughout the United States. Volunteers also visit and spread cheer to Veterans in nursing homes. This is truly where the motto “Keep Them Smiling in Beds of White” is put to work. Clowns visit, comfort items are handed out, hospital parties are attended, lap robes, Afghans and other items are made and time is just spent in visiting and showing our Veterans how much their service means to us. 

In 2016 we officially changed our name to **Military Order of the Cootie Auxiliary** and welcomed male members into our organization.

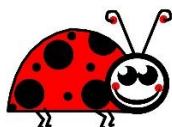

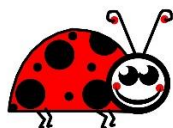

MEMBERS INFORMATION

1. At each GRAND MOCA meeting we have a “fun- fines” these funds go to the health and happiness funds, it is a general amount called by the ‘Fun Officer’ who will state the fine while checking your membership card. Odd amounts always! The meeting dues collected will be \$1.01.

As an example: If you are not wearing black shoes, the fine is \$.26 or, something like this: If you are not wearing shoes, the fine could be \$.26. **REMINDER COOTIES ALWAYS USE ODD NUMBERS.** Each “fun request” is at the call of the Fun Officer.

2. As in the VFWA, we will show our membership cards at each meeting. If you do not have your card, you may have someone vouch for you or pay a fine of a small amount.

3. At each meeting, we will have items for drawings in support of our various programs. Those who have purchased tickets for a \$1 per ticket will participate in a drawing. (It only takes one ticket to win.) Each table will draw tickets near to the close of the meetings and the winner takes their prize.

What is the purpose of the tables? The tables represent the various programs of the MOCA. The money you contribute here you should also report to the MOCA Auxiliary. Some who win a basket, take the basket to their VFW Post and offer tickets there to make money for the MOCA Projects of their Auxiliary or they may keep the basket and enjoy.

4. The MOCA Clowns will dress in their clown outfits and visit the MOC meetings at Grand, taking candy or sugarless treats. The MOC members usually contribute money to the clowns.
