Elocution: the skill of clear and expressive speech, especially of distinct pronunciation and articulation:

As Speech and Drama teachers, we are empowering students of all ages to achieve natural and intelligible speech habits. As well as addressing functional speech disorders with closely guided

speech exercises, our lessons provide students with an opportunity to convert this training into habits by applying it in fun, creative drama activities. Common challenges we work on include:

- The 'th', 't', 's', 'r', and 'l' sounds
- Lip laziness
- Rapid speech
- Mumbling and throaty tone
- The elision (removal) of sounds
- Unnatural speech rhythm
- Inappropriate pause and stress
- Inappropriate intonation (rising and falling tones)
- Monotony (lacking vocal colour and expression)
- Shallow breathing / breathy tone
- Faulty tones such as excess nasality
- Lack of resonance (speaks too quietly or too loudly)
- Lack of non-verbal communication (eye contact, gesture and facial
- expression)
- Confidence to communicate

Fees:
