Thank you for considering volunteering with us! You need to be 18+ to register for GUBB volunteer opportunities and be able to make a minimum volunteer commitment.

Opportunity	We are a non-profit organisation who help families save money whilst reducing waste and inequality. We mainly achieve this by facilitating the re-use of good quality school uniform and baby items from our GUBB hub located in Winsford. We need donation helpers to join our GUBB Team to collect, sort, and organise donated items, restocking shelves which can be <u>outside</u> of opening times.
Commitment	Be available for one collection per week.

It is a flexible opportunity where we can work with donors to schedule a mutually convenient time to collect item(s), so let us know your availability and we can match to collection requests.

Tasks	You will collect donations from local homes and/or community locations, sorting these donations into those to be sold in the community shop and those to be recycled or donated to other causes. It also includes the cleaning or folding of donated items and the restocking of the shop floor. The collection tasks will be allocated, and you can accept them if it is convenient.

<p>Teamwork</p>	<p>We have volunteers who run our community shop and who are responsible for providing our customer service. Donation helpers assist our shop volunteers by collecting, sorting, and re-stocking the shop floor.</p>

In our donation helpers, we look for friendly, approachable volunteers who are able to drive. They have access to their own vehicle, are able to undertake light-lifting commensurate with shop work and have basic IT skills, similar to skills for smart-phone use, to accept collection tasks.

We pay fuel or energy expenses to cover the cost of collecting donated items and bringing them to our premises. The mileage from our premise to the collection address and back again for each collection is reimbursed in line with our expenses policy. We do not pay expenses for the cost of you traveling from your home to our premises. However, if this cost would be a barrier to you being able to volunteer, please speak to us.

In return, as a volunteer you will have opportunities to give back to your local community, make genuine connections with others, and have the opportunity to take part in our community events.
