Opening of regular meeting

Admin Report:

- 1. Employment Security has a credit of \$473.51
- 2. Looking into our Financial Statement from the County Treasurer. Discovered there is \$421,144.24 in our general account. There is \$128,922.87 in our investment account which has earned \$6417.29 in interest in the last year. We could be earning more interest with adjusting our funds. It was agreed to move \$300,000 from the general account to the investment account with the intent to earn more interest.

Chiefs Reports: See attached for full report.

- 1. Emergency Reporting has become outdated. The local fire departments are switching over to ESO and First Due. Switching to ESO has been difficult for many. First Due seems to be a good option combining both iSpy and Emergency Reporting into one system with easier reporting system in place. However, it is \$8000 per year. We currently pay \$1893.00 for Emergency Reporting and \$1200.00 for iSpy. So for now, we will continue to use Emergency Reporting and iSpy.
- 2. Station 244. Chief Oatey wants \$22,500 approved to partially finish the meeting/training room. He believes adding metal to the walls with exposed insulation and texturing and paint the drywall wall already there will be a good first step. Chuck moved to approve \$22,500 to finish the walls in \$244, Pat seconds.

- 2. Station 244 update: Water tank is still leaking. 250 gals per day leaking. John Kutscka is investigating both hydrant drains if they close completely.
