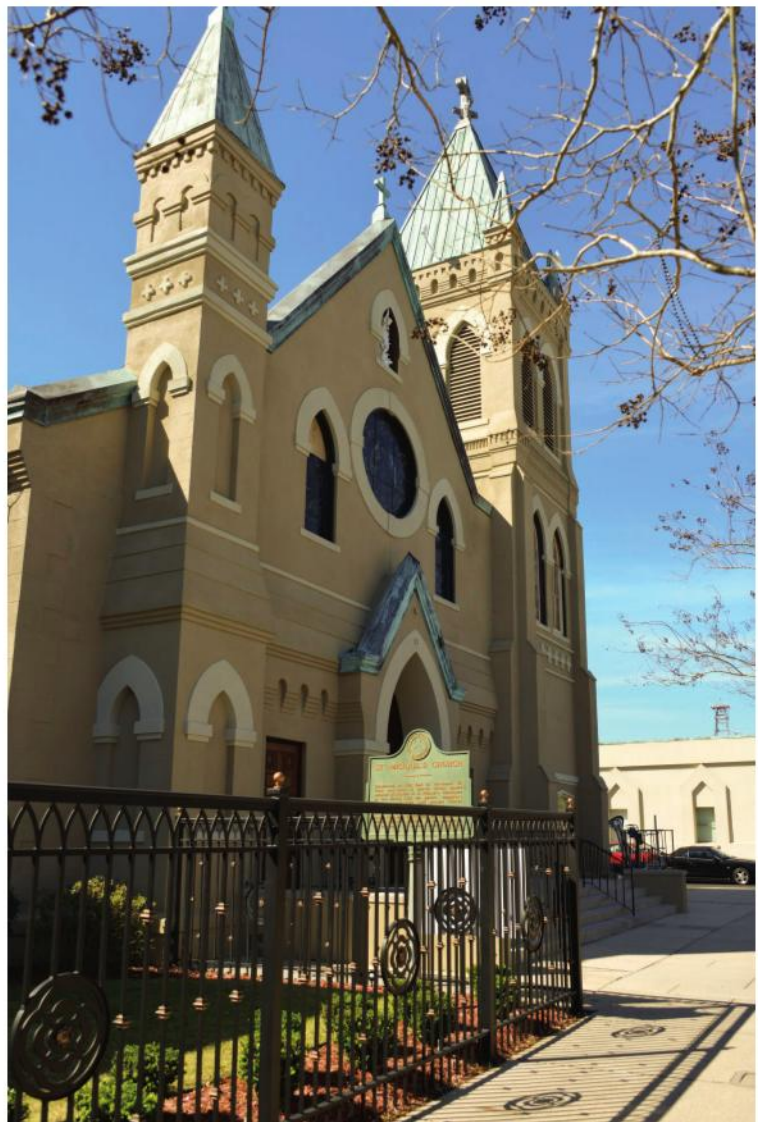

FROM FR. JOE

My dear friends, I am excited to welcome Dr. Tom Neal back to our parish this Saturday for our Liturgical ministries retreat. This Saturday, a morning retreat will be offered for those who are serving in our Liturgical ministries (Lectors, Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, Sacristans, Ushers, Greeters, the Altar Guild, the Guardians, and the Choir). I want to encourage all of our parishioners to take some part in volunteering to serve at our Masses. Our Sunday Masses require approximately 15 people cooperating together in various roles, not including the choirs! That’s about 40-50 people each weekend if we include the choirs.

The retreat will be all about how these ministries are not just a service to the community or to the parish, but a real and intimate service to Jesus. He is the true priest who presides over our worship and our prayer. Serving in any of our Liturgies (which is a word that comes from the Greek and simply refers to the official “work” of the Church) is a powerful way to connect with Jesus at an even deeper level.

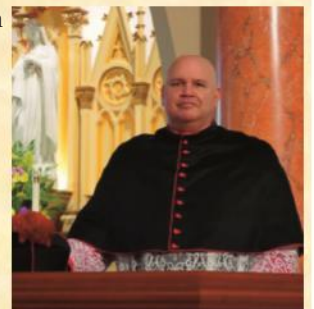
If you are interested in learning more about these ministries or serving in them, please feel free to attend our retreat on Saturday, we would love to have you participate! Even if you choose not to be a part of our Liturgical ministries, it is important to understand your mission in coming to the Mass. The formal volunteers are the ones I have listed above, but every single one of us should approach the Mass as a mission. We can be praying for the people around us, specifically and individually, we can be praying for the ministers and volunteers who do serve in an official capacity, we can pray for the intentions and needs for the Church, the Pope, the Bishop, and those intentions that God has inspired us to bring.

New people and visitors are coming to the Basilica all the time. If you see someone that you do not recognize, introduce yourself! Welcome people to St. Michael’s as an ambassador-parishioner. There are probably plenty of people who come every week whose names you don’t know...introduce yourself to them too! We can pray for one another much more effectively if we know each other. We all come to church with needs on our hearts, how wonderful it would be if we knew that, not only the priest or the “official Church” was praying for us, but all of our brother and sister parishioners.

St. Michael’s desires to be a tight-knit community of faith, this is how that kind of community is formed. While I hope that all of you who are not connected with one of our Liturgical ministries will consider participating, I trust that all of you will open your hearts to knowing one another and praying for one another from the heart. St. James reminds us in our second reading today that, for our faith to be alive and authentic, it must be lived and lived in action. Take action today, get to know your fellow parishioners, welcome and greet our visitors, and by so doing, share the love and grace of Jesus Christ with everyone you meet!
