

BASILICA WEDDING ATTIRE

VISUAL GUIDE

A wedding at the Basilica is a sacred celebration.
Attire should reflect the dignity of the Sacrament and respect for this holy place.

BRIDE

APPROPRIATE



Elegant, modest, and respectful of the sacred space.

NOT APPROPRIATE



Excessively revealing, sheer, or inappropriate for a church setting.

VEILS & TRAINS ARE WELCOME, provided they can be safely managed within the Basilica.

GROOM

APPROPRIATE



Formal, respectful attire is appropriate to the significance of the Sacrament

NOT APPROPRIATE



Casual attire does not reflect the dignity of the occasion

WEDDING PARTY

BRIDESMAIDS

APPROPRIATE



Dresses should be formal, tasteful, and allow reverent participation in the liturgy.

NOT APPROPRIATE



Too revealing, distracting, or not suitable for a church setting.

GROOMSMEN

APPROPRIATE



Suits, tuxedos, or military dress uniforms are appropriate.

NOT APPROPRIATE



Casual attire is not appropriate

CHILDREN IN THE WEDDING PARTY



Children should wear age-appropriate, formal attire that allows them to participate comfortably and safely.

FINAL REMINDER

The Basilica is a house of God and the setting for the Sacrament of Matrimony. Attire should show reverence, helping everyone focus on the beauty of the liturgy and the vows being exchanged.

When in doubt, choose modesty and elegance.
