



#### FROM FR. JOE

My dear friends, life is worth celebrating! I am proud of the fact that we are making our humble efforts as a parish to contribute to the promotion of celebrating and honoring life. We can never forget that every single life is a gift from God. Every gift of God is good and worthy of celebration. But life, especially human life, uniquely created in the image and likeness of Almighty God holds a supreme dignity among all of creation.

Our parish Honoring Life team sponsors our Fridays for Life every Friday at the Basilica. These Fridays are no different from the other weekday liturgies with the exception of the fact that we pray for intentions connected to honoring life in every way possible. We pray for the unborn, for the elderly, for families, for young people, for the sick, for the abandoned, and any other intentions we can think of that help us grow in reverence for the gift of life.

This Friday, August 16, Dr. Tom Neal will be coming to offer a talk to us during the Holy Hour entitled:

## "Marian Living - On Earth as it is in Heaven."

Mary provides a pivotal witness to the gift of life. Dr. Tom Neal presently serves as Chief of Evangelization and Mission Engagement for the diocese of Pensacola-Tallahassee. Dr. Tom has a Masters in Theology and a Ph.D in Religion and Ethics. He spent 15 years serving the catechetical mission of the Church in Florida and Iowa, and then served for 11 years as Professor of Spiritual Theology at Notre Dame Seminary in New Orleans. He and his wife Patti have been married for 29 years and have four adult children and a grandson.

Bishop Wack recently came to our parish to speak about the gift of the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick. Later this year, in December, Bishop Martin Holley will be with us to discuss the tender care of family and the dignity that we afford our relatives when we treat them with love and respect for the entirety of their lives.

As many of you know, there is a proposed amendment coming before the Florida legislature dealing with abortion. Referred to as "Amendment 4," this proposed legislation will allow for unprecedented access to abortion in our state. It provides for the possibility of minors procuring abortion without the consent of their parents, and for caregivers to make these decisions without the necessary intervention of doctors.

Of course, as Catholics we are opposed to abortion in all its forms as an offense against the gift of life given by the Creator. Even in the most extreme circumstances, our solution as individuals and as a society cannot be the destruction or killing of innocent life, especially children. Too easily do people de-humanize the unborn child, referring to him or her with medical terms rather than personal ones.

I urge you to become more involved in this important ministry of honoring life and to attend the talk sponsored by our team this Friday. We have so much to learn from the example of Mary's life and her attentiveness to caring for and protecting the unborn, Divine Life in her

womb.
