



FROM FR. JOE

My dear friends, in the Gospel passage this Sunday, Jesus cites a passage from Isaiah and applies it to the Scribes and Pharisees who are questioning His practices. He says to them: "Well did Isaiah prophesy about you hypocrites, as it is written: 'This people honors me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me; in vain do they worship me, [...]" How can we ensure that our hearts are near to Jesus rather than far from Him? I'd like to offer some thoughts on that this week.

Firstly, Jesus says this to people who are questioning the fact that He did not require His disciples to wash their hands (in a ritual way) before eating. He is frustrated with their adherence to human traditions while they ignore the more important matters of God. So, one way that we can work to unite our hearts to Christ's is by focusing on what really matters.

For example, how much of our week is given over to working out our salvation? How much of our time is spent engaging in the things of God? When we become angry or upset, is it over events that have anything to do with God or Church or salvation? Do the things in life that cause us anxiety or worry have anything to do with God? These questions can help us gauge where our hearts stand in relation to the heart of Christ.

Secondly, we can look to the place that prayer has in our life. Are we content to be as distant from God as we are, or are we making efforts to draw near to Him in action and in prayer? How can we hope to be of a like mind and heart with God if we do not spend significant time in our lives listening to Him? We waste so much time in frivolous pursuits, do we expect that those things will somehow bring us closer to Christ?

Finally, Jesus goes on to say that the people who live far from His heart worship in vain. God help us! How much of our worship is in vain? Jesus calls us to worship Him in spirit and in truth. Our prayer and worship cannot be just words and gestures. Our worship must flow from a life lived in Christ if it is to be authentic.


Jesus, later in the same passage of the Gospel, tells His listeners that our evils originate in our hearts, from within. But, this is an invitation to transformation! Jesus does not doom us to live in evil or vain worship, but rather calls us to conversion and change. Yes, our evils and sins originate in our own hearts, but we can invite Jesus in instead to be renewed from within! He, alone, can transform our sinful hearts, hearts of stone, into loving and compassionate hearts like His own.

As we come together for the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass this weekend, may this be our prayer: that the amazing gift of the Eucharist, about which we have heard all throughout the readings from John's Gospel last month,

would find in us hearts eager and ready for transformation in Christ, that our hearts might be near to and like His own Sacred Heart.
