



#### FROM FR. JOE

My dear friends, this is an exciting day for the Basilica family as we head to the cinema! In the world of today, visual media dominates communication. Evangelization is a consecrated form of communication, as we seek to tell people about Jesus by communicating His life and His mission. I hope that all of you have been able to peruse the video content on the Basilica's website (stmichaelbasilica.com).

Every reading of today's Mass reminds us of the need, the call, the challenge, and the benefit of evangelization. How can we tell people about the amazing things that God continues to do in our world? One way, for sure, is by telling the story of what Jesus has done in us. Telling our story does not require theological training, nor does it mean that we are authorities in Church teaching. It simply means that Jesus has done something in our life that we wish to share. We can make Christ known to those who do not know Him. How amazing is that?!

The power of a visual experience was recognized by a phrase often attributed to Confucius in the 7th century: A picture is worth a thousand words. I am so pleased that, through the generous time and talent of those who have given themselves to this work, that we are able to present a visual expression of our parish story. This is different from our parish history! There are so many stories to tell about St. Michael's. We are currently working on a film version of our parish history and the legacy of the Catholic presence in Pensacola. But, the story we are showcasing today is about what Jesus is doing in our parish family now.


We do not have to excavate the past to find relics of the Holy Spirit's work among us when we can see Him at work in the lives our people today. He is healing and inspiring and challenging and comforting and calling... today. How can we be witness to this and not share the story of what He is doing? In the Gospel this weekend, Jesus heals a man who is deaf. He is still trying to maintain a low profile at this point in His ministry and orders them not to tell anyone about it. Mark's Gospel relates: "He ordered them not to tell anyone. But the more he ordered them not to, the more they proclaimed it."

Now, Jesus has laid all of His cards on the table; His mission is clear. Far from holding us back and instructing us not to tell anyone about what He has done, the Lord has commissioned and commanded us to make Him known. How can we hold back? My encouragement to you this weekend is to consider your story. Pray through each year and decade of your life. Ask the Lord to show you, to reveal to you His hand at work in the events of your personal history. He is there!

You have a story to tell. I hope you will tell it!
