

### MEMORIAL OF SAINT PIUS OF PIETRELCINA, PRIEST



Saint Pio of Pietrelcina, known as Padre Pio (1887–1968), was an Italian Capuchin friar and mystic who became famous for his deep prayer, spiritual guidance, and miraculous signs. From a young age, he experienced visions and spiritual battles, and later bore the stigmata—the wounds of Christ—which he carried for fifty years. Despite suspicion and restrictions from Church authorities, thousands of pilgrims sought him out for confession and healing, drawn by his humility and holiness. He spent his life in service to God, prayer, and the care of souls, founding a hospital for the suffering, and was canonized as a saint in 2002.

Padre Pio's stigmata were mysterious wounds on his body that resembled the wounds of Christ's crucifixion.

In 1918, while praying before a crucifix after Mass, he received these marks: bleeding wounds in his hands, feet, and side. They remained visible for about fifty years, until shortly before his death in 1968, when they healed without leaving scars.

Doctors who examined him could not find a medical explanation for the wounds, which never became infected despite being open. The Church initially investigated him with caution, even restricting his ministry for a time, but the stigmata became one of the signs that drew thousands of pilgrims to him, many believing it was proof of his deep union with Christ's suffering.

For fifty years, the wounds bled daily and required bandages, yet when he passed away, they were completely healed, leaving only smooth skin with no scars or marks. This sudden disappearance was considered by many to be miraculous, and it deepened the mystery surrounding his life and holiness.
