

FROM FR. JOE

My dear friends, we have a beautiful invitation from God in the readings this Sunday. The Lord promises to bring His people home through the prophet Jeremiah. He reminds us that He understands our life and circumstances in the Letter to the Hebrews. God's love shines through in both of these passages. He wants us to be with Him. He wants us to know how much He understands our life. But it is in the Gospel that we see the powerful invitation to action.

Jesus calls the blind Bartimaeus, or rather He instructs His disciples to call Him. What a powerful image of the Church at work! In fact, when they speak to Bartimaeus, they encourage Him with the fact that Jesus is calling him, but He is calling Bartimaeus through the ministry of the disciples. Really, this Gospel passage is a twofold call to action. On the one hand, Jesus is calling us to receive His grace, to rise up out of the malaise of our sometimes slothful inactivity and to go to Him. On the other hand, He is sending us out to those whom He is calling to be His messengers and to encourage them to take heart in the call they receive.

Either way, what a grace! Of course, we cannot be disciples of Jesus without first going to Him as the fount of grace for our own salvation and spiritual wellbeing. As disciples, redeemed by His love, how can we ignore the call to ministry and service, recognizing the vast number of people in need of God's grace and the message of His love?

We can always ask why God uses His disciples rather than choosing to act on His own, alone, but the plain fact of the matter is that, again and again, consistently, Jesus empowers us with His grace and calls us to act. Why take the extra step of telling His disciples, "Call him."? But this is how God works. What happens to Bartimaeus should the disciples fail to obey the call of Christ? What happens to Bartimaeus without the encouragement of others in his life who motivate him to respond?

The disciples, more than any others could, recognize the crossroads of the moment of encounter with Christ. I think all of us can look back to decision points in our lives in which we had the chance to say "yes" or "no" to Jesus calling us. I would imagine that we look at the "no" moments with regret and the "yes" moments with gratitude. That is certainly my experience. When we see someone at that point in their lives, who better to encourage them than someone who knows, experientially, the joy of saying "yes" to Jesus and the ultimate disappointment of allowing those opportunities to pass by with a "no" or simply a lack of response altogether.

These readings are an opportunity for us to reflect on the invitation at work in our lives now, at this moment. How is God calling you to respond to the invitation of grace? How is He calling you to encourage those people in

your lives who need it the most? Consider this prayerfully on this, the Lord's Day, and be sure that your response to both of those calls is a resounding and joyful "yes"!
