CCFC PROGRAM OVERVIEW

- Charleston City FC is a 501 (c) 3 nonprofit public benefit corporation dedicated to the sport of soccer.
- We are an active member of the South Carolina Youth Soccer Association (SCYSA) and the United States Youth Soccer Organization (USYS).
- CCFC and its Governing organizations are all accountable to the United States Soccer Federation, commonly referred to as U.S. Soccer, which is the official governing body of the sport of soccer in the United States.
- CCFC is divided into three primary lines of business, Soccer Programs, and Fundraising.









SOCCER PROGRAMS

Led by the Executive Director, CCFC currently operates with competitive youth teams for boys and girls between the ages of eight and nineteen, who play soccer nine months out of the year, developmental academy program for kids between the age of four and seven, a First Touch program for kids between the age of four and seven. TEAM SELECTION PROCESS

After Tryouts, our coaching staff will sit down and review all accepted players to begin the Team selection process.

Players & Teams will not be allowed to play more than 2 years above their age level and that decision is at the sole discretion of the DOC.

CLUB DUES

Club dues are not collected to generate a profit for the organization.

These fees are necessary to cover the extensive costs necessary to run our soccer club. Costs include the expenses related to the following:

- league registration for all teams
- league referee fees

- field usage
- > field development
- > maintenance
- professional admin staff and coaches

Club Dues do not cover...

- \$30 Try Out Fee (Non-refundable)
- Uniform Kits \$145
- Tournament fees
- VEO Recording System \$95.00 (once annually)
- Travel Expenses



CLUB DUES CONTINUED.....

Rate Increase

- > U8-U18 will increase slightly to offset increase operational costs
 - Prorated monthly changes for most teams will be less than \$30

New Payment Policy

- > Payments more than 10 days late = Email to Parent as Reminder
 - No Guest Playing
- > Payments more than 30 days late =Loss of playing privileges.
 - Once payment is made, playing privileges will be reinstated.
 - Loss of privileges could include but not limited to the following:
 - Loss of player card (without a player card, they cannot play in any game or tournament)
 - No practices
- Payments more than 60 days late, without a plan in place Expulsion
