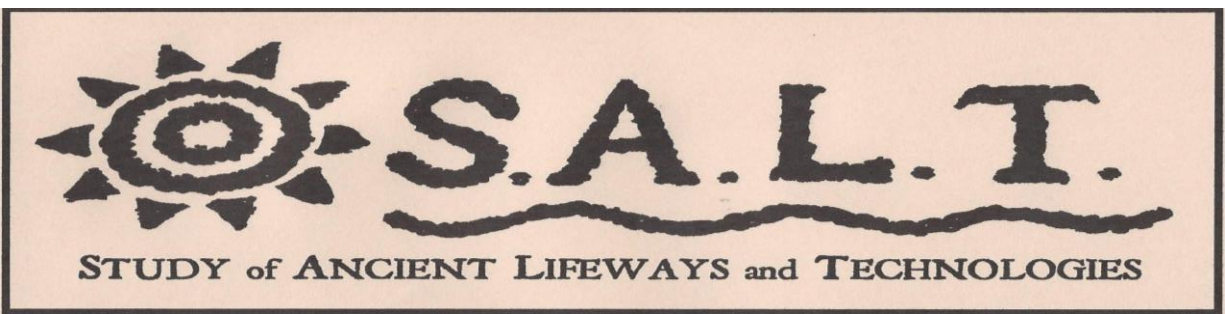




S.A.L.T. MISSION STATEMENT

Make a BONE NEEDLE and BONE AWL with Ron Moses

Join us for a workshop exploring the process of making basic "First Tools" from animal bones. Learn how to make bone needles and awls, like those used by ancient peoples for thousands of years. This is a hands-on opportunity covering:

- How bone needles and awls changed the ancient world
- Sourcing and selecting bones for tool projects.
 - Methods for creating bone blanks
 - Making the eye of the needle
- Bone shaping, polishing, and preserving.

SKILL #1 CUTTING TOOL: Level I

Make a flake and discoidal blade.

SKILL #2 CORDAGE: Level I

Make a uniform 3-foot length of cordage.

SKILL #3 FRICTION FIRE: Level I

Demonstrate one method of primitive fire starting
