Archaeological finds dating back to 6500-3000 in Turkey and Russia suggest that early humans had developed skills in processing wool into usable items, i.e. "felt making" or "wet felting" This presentation on Saturday will briefly discuss this process and participants will have an opportunity to try a newer, decorative wool technique, called "needle felting." Equipment will be provided but small kits will also be available for purchase.

SKILL #1 CUTTING TOOL: Level I

Make a flake and discoidal blade.



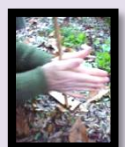
SKILL #2 CORDAGE: Level I
