
CodeRED – The New Mason County Emergency Alert System for Residents

CodeRED is a new tool to immediately alert residents of community notices plus fire, weather, and other emergencies that may affect our area. When you sign up for CodeRED, you may enter landline and/or cellular phones, email(s) and your address to be used in notification of emergencies, alerts and updates regarding our county and specific areas. Fawn Lake has been added as a notification group.

To sign up follow the instructions below:


- 1) Open your web browser and go to https://masoncountywa.gov/index.php
- 2) Scroll down on the Home Page, viewing the lefthand side blue bar to "ONLINE SERVICES" and select Emergency Alert Notification Signup (pictured below)



- 3) Create a new account, entering a username and password.
- 4) Continue to enter your address and notification phone and/or email for both general and emergency alerts.
- 5) Select your notification areas: Arcadia/Kamilche and Fawn Lake would cover your home area.
