MESSAGES FROM OUR BOARD OF TRUSTEES

Bill Knight: Water (submitted by Steve Jacobson on behalf of Bill Knight)

The AC pipe replacement at the dam is set to begin mid-December and is expected to cause short term water shut -offs in stages throughout the project. We will be communicating shut-off information as quickly as we receive it. This section of AC pipe is being replaced for a number of reasons.

- Most importantly to get some of the old pipe evaluated and hopefully give us an update on its condition.
- We are upgrading the pipe to 6 inch for future fire suppression.
- We are finding out what it takes to do a project this big.
- The pipe we replace should not have to be replaced for a hundred years.
- Mason County PUD is partnering with us and sharing the expense of the project, for about \$20,000.

Steve Jacobson: Roads

We have now completed road repairs for 2023. The repairs were focused on Crescent Drive, from the office to Cabana. It also included a speed bump installed just in front of the exit gate, so that we can reduce damage that was being done to the spike unit that prevents entry. This unit would cost \$32,000 to replace at this time.

In addition, the speed bump extends to the entry side to slow entry into Fawn Lake. This is to help prevent gate damage for people attempting to sneak through the gate.

Steve Jacobson: Bylaws

The Bylaw Violation Review Committee is now reviewing properties throughout Fawn Lake to insure that owners are complying with the Bylaws. The intent is not to generate fines, but to seek compliance. Most of the complaints revolve around yards not mown, and items that should not be stored in outdoor locations and in the yard. Please take a look at your property and make it presentable.

Bump for 5 mph @ Gate

Security Lights for Fawn Lake

We have security cameras at our gate and cabana, which are undergoing an upgrade. Now, we have added motion-activated lighting for walkers and to alert neighboring homes of after-hour activity in our community. Motion lights are recommended by MCSD for added security. Please report crime or thefts to MCSD at 360-426-4441 or to 911 when criminal activity is in progress.

Mason County Sherrif (MCS) reporting system shows crime in Fawn Lake is much, much lower than the rest of Shelton.



- Report criminal or suspicious activity in progress to 911 immediately.
- Always report any vandalism, theft, etc AFTER it has happened to the non-emergency number 360-426-4441. This also helps to populate crime stats on the MCSD website.
- Store ladders out of burglar/vandals reach (2nd story windows are less likely to be locked or they may break in through an attic window)
- Park your RV away from the home to avoid its' use as a "ladder"
- Criminals prefer cluttered, closely spaced lots to stay hidden and move from house to house taking easy-to-carry valuables.
- Keep all doors/windows locked on home and car Use dowels (cut to fit) inside of window frames to better secure windows
- Keep curtains closed and leave a radio or TV on when you are gone.
- Use dusk-to-dawn lights on your property to discourage prowlers.
- Use security cameras with recorded activity clips to best capture malicious activity
- Clean your security camera lens regularly
- Do not post vacation comments or pictures on social media until you get back home.
- DO NOT OPEN GATE FOR CARS OR PEOPLE who are not your guests
