Annual Fawn Lake Garage Sale

If you haven't gotten those cubbyholes cleaned out and your old "stuff" ready for our garage sale—now's the time to get busy! Our annual garage sale will be Saturday, the 10th from 8am* to 4pm. For those of you who are new to the community, each year Fawn Lake opens the gate for a day to allow you to hold an individual garage sale at your property.

*This year we will be doing a special resident-only "early bird" shopping from 8am to 9am. Several residents have requested the opportunity to shop their neighbors' sales before the general public comes in. Another great benefit to living in Fawn Lake! For those of you hosting sales, please be ready by 8am for your neighbors to shop before the public comes in at 9am.

On that same day, FLAG will be hosting a Craftsmen's Fair in the grassy area just inside the gate. Vendors will have tables and canopies set up and we are hoping the sight of all those canopies will entice people into the community, increasing the amount of potential buyers at your sale. If you are an artist or craftsmen and would like to have a table at the Fair, contact Mike Salvetti at 360-358-8780 to reserve one. Tables are \$10 per vendor, you must provide your own canopy.

Fawn Lake Maintenance Commission pays for local advertising of the event, but we count on you to get the word out to your friends, family and co-workers! Tell 'em to come on down, there is plenty to see and lots of great deals! Let's put that social media to use!

The gate will open to the public at 9am and close at 4pm.

Fawn Lake Water Restrictions start June 1st

We will begin water restrictions June 1st. For lots with an oddnumber address, you are free to water on the odd days of the month. For lots with an even-number address, you can water on the even days of the month. If you feel you need to vary your watering from this established schedule, pick up a "Request for Variance" form in the office. This permit is not required for hand watering, only for sprinklers and installed sprinkler systems.

Jessica Pense: Nominations & Elections

We are pleased to announce that Marnie Benefield and Curt Pense have both officially joined the Board of Trustees. They will be designated their committee assignments soon. Thank you and welcome aboard!

Steve Jacobson: Treasurer

Board Members have spent the last two months working to get payments from all members toward their assessment. The Board gave one extra month to pay, with interest being charged. In addition, the actions included two mailings, and our office folks calling two separate times to remind owners that payment was due.

With all of that effort we wound up with 12 properties that had liens filed. Since that time 3 have paid. We are spending an inordinate amount of time finishing up this process, but will complete all actions necessary.

Matt Matincheck: Lake & Dam

Lake weeds will be sprayed Friday, June 2nd. Please do not cut any weeds or lily pads at this time. The chemicals are absorbed through the leaves of the plant. If the plants have been cut, the chemical will not kill off the plant. We will send an E-Service announcement out when it is ok to cut the weeds. When you do cut the weeds, be sure and remove the floating debris from the water and dispose of with your yard waste. Rotting vegetation just creates more muck in the bottom of the lake and encourages more weed growth!

PUD Pole Inspections

PUD #3 contacted us and they will begin pole inspections in our community starting August 1st. They expect it to take 2 to 3 days. If you have a PUD pole on your property, they will need to enter your property to inspect it. In the rare instance that PUD crews must replace a pole which may be deemed unsafe, requiring replacement and an interruption in service, customers affected by the outage will be notified in advance either by letter or a knock at the door. As always, the PUD recommends that you protect your electronics with surge protectors. Please be considerate; slow down and give them a wide berth when you see them working in the community.


