Live For Him Ministries Children's Academy Bugiri, Uganda June 2024 Report

We have come to the end of the month, the Lord has been so gracious to us and we are blessed to be serving the lives of these needy children. We have a total of 167 children that we are ministering to. Our teaching staff has a total of 13 teachers. They are very committed to the ministry of teaching these children. Our teachers have received the salaries for the month of June.

We received support that Live For Him Ministries sent. We have enough food for this term. I bought enough food and some items we are buying as the need arises.

I have paid the tuition fees for the 6 students on scholarships.

All our children are doing well, we have 22 children who are candidates, and they will be sitting for national exams later this year in November. We need to keep them in prayers because after they have passed, they will need sponsorship to join secondary school.

These same children requested us that we can help them and allow them to be accommodated at the school so that they can have enough time to do their revisions because back at their homes there is no power so no light for them to use while revising their books once it's dark. Plus because their parents struggle to find food they only have one meal which is served at the school, so I got a small solar panel and a battery plus some bulbs so that they can stay at school and study, because our school also has got no power connected. I got one of the teachers who is staying at the school with these children, the purpose is to help them be able to revise their books so they can pass the national exams excellently.

So currently we are now feeding an extra small dinner for 22 children, however this does not affect us on our budgets in food

The only challenge is they don't have a mattress, as God provides it would be better for the school to have bunk beds and mattresses plus mosquito nets to stop malaria. We currently have 4 children sick of malaria in the whole school.

For them to sleep at the school, we just separated learning classes to create accommodation rooms. We at least need more rooms so that some rooms can be for studies and some for accommodations, I talked to the engineer who can help me to design a building plus costs and he is working on it.

Our learning rooms have a very poor dusty floor because it's not cemented. We would love to cement our floor to keep away the dust, otherwise we are having some children who have jiggers in their feet. Our children do not have shoes so they are easily affected. If we can have the floor cemented that will be great.

Elizabeth was able to make reusable sanitary pads for all the girls who are in need, this is one of the challenges that affects girls, some would even leave without anyone knowing. We thank the lord we are doing our best to help every child.

Another current need is desks for children. In order for our children to write, they place the books on their knees. To help them improve on their learning and writing they need at least a desk where they can place a book and learn to write well,
