GENERAL PHOTOGRAPHY POLICIES

- The Edinburg World Birding Center restricts the use of props to certain areas in our grounds. Please contact our office for more information on allowed props and their designated areas. All props <u>must</u> be removed from the site.
- The use of balloons is allowed, but photographers and their guests are prohibitied from releasing them. The use of confetti is strictly prohibitied.
- Moving or removing plants or structures that are part of the Wetlands is **strictly prohibited**.
- No photographers, assistants or subjects may step in garden beds, on water features, inside ponds, or places other than on designated paths and grassy areas. Climbing or mounting equipment in trees or on buildings is not permitted.
- All photo subjects must be fully and appropriately clothed. Swimsuit photo shoots are not permitted. Apparel changes are not allowed on the grounds. Please use restroom facilities located in the Interpretive Center or nearby Municipal Park to change.
- All cords or wires must be placed and guarded in a way that doesn't alter the pathways and put Wetlands visitors at risk.
- Photographers will be held accountable for their actions and those of clients, crew members and subjects if they damage Edinburg Scenic Wetlands & World Birding Center facilities and property.
- The transportation of personal belongings such as props and camera equipment is undertaken at your own discretion and risk. Kindly refrain from requesting staff members to monitor or safeguard your belongings.

RELATED RULES

- Clients are encouraged to arrive camera-ready, as there are no dressing room facilities. On site restrooms can be used, but are only accessible 8 am to 5 pm, Monday Saturday.
- Display your permit prominently on your chest area or equipment.
- Set up your shoot in a manner that does not impact visitors or disrupt events and maintenance.

PORTRAIT & SPECIAL OCCASION PHOTOGRAPHY POLICIES

We are delighted that you are considering Edinburg Scenic Wetlands & World Birding Center (EWBC) as the location for your photos. The guidelines outlined below are intended for all guests, however reservations are recommended for those who wish to use the Edinburg Scenic Wetlands & World Birding Center as a backdrop for posed or directed photography. We ask all photographers to please help us maintain the integrity of the Wetlands by honoring these policies. They are intended to ensure that EWBC can fulfill its mission of protecting native habitat and increasing the understanding of birds and wildlife.

GUEST PHOTOGRAPHY

Photographs are a wonderful way to remember your visit. For your own enjoyment, visitors and members are welcome to take snapshot photographs of plants, wildlife, individuals and subjects that capture your visit. EWBC defines a **snapshot** as an informal photograph that is shot spontaneously and quickly without artistic intent. Guests should still observe our policies. You may share your photos of the Wetlands on social media outlets, including Facebook, Twitter and Instagram.

DEFINITION OF PORTRAIT PHOTOGRAPHY

Edinburg Scenic Wetlands & World Birding Center defines portrait photography as all wedding, engagement, quinceañera, family, maternity, portfolio, prom, graduation, and any other posed portraiture of individuals by professional photographers, as well as semi-pro, pro-am or amateur photographers, whether paid or unpaid. Edinburg Scenic Wetlands & World Birding Center reserves the right to further define Portrait Photography on a case-by-case basis.

DEFINITION OF COMMERCIAL PHOTOGRAPHY & VIDEOGRAPHY

Edinburg Scenic Wetlands & World Birding Center defines commercial photography as fashion shoots, advertisement and promotion. Commercial photographers and videographers, please see the City of Edinburg's photo and video policy. All commercial photo shoot applications must be submitted <u>at least four weeks</u> in advance to Edinburg Scenic Wetlands & World Birding Center for approval by Edinburg Scenic Wetlands & World Birding Center and the City of Edinburg. Artists seeking to make **independent films** must also apply for approval in advance. Edinburg Scenic Wetlands & World Birding Center reserves the right to further define Commercial Photography on a case-by-case basis. For commercial requests only, please email EWBC Manager.

PORTRAIT PHOTO POLICY

All portrait photographers are required to schedule <u>at least 1 business day</u> in advance by calling (956) 381-9922. Please note we prefer the photographer reserves the session.

Portrait mini-sessions: In order to fulfill our mission with regard to a positive visitor experience, Edinburg Scenic Wetlands & World Birding Center prohibits photographers from scheduling mini-sessions.

Reservations and Permit: Reservations are required at least 1 business day in advance. To reserve your photo shoot, please call (956) 381-9922, Monday through Friday between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m.

PLEASE NOTE: We only allow <u>two</u> photo sessions on site at a time, and reserve the right of refusal if the requested photo session will interfere with concurrent programs or conflict with other preapproved photo shoot reserverations.

Professional Photographers: Portrait Photographers who wish to schedule multiple photo shoots during the year can purchase the **Photography Pass.** The fee for the pass is \$150 for one year. Photography Pass Holders do not pay the per-session fee for groups of 15 or less.

All Photographers are limited to one photo session per day.

Artists and Nature Photographers:

When visiting on their own, artists and nature photographers do not need to make a reservation or pay the portrait photography rate. General Admission rates apply to their visit. However, artists and nature photographers must adhere to the guidelines listed below, avoiding damage to plants, wildlife and disruption of other visitors or EWBC activities.

RESERVATIONS

Please call (956) 381-9922 to request a photo session. Please note that Portait Photography Session are limited to one photo shoot per day per Photographer and begin between the hours of **8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Saturday and 12 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. on Sunday.** All photographers must exit the Edinburg Scenic Wetlands & World Birding Center grounds 30 minutes prior to closing. Photography pass holders may schedule additional hours for an additional fee, upon approval. Please see "Evening Photo Shoot" below.

PRICING

Please call (956) 381-9922 at least one business day in advance to request a reservation. Please note that reservations are only accepted **Tuesdays-Saturdays from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Mondays, 12 p.m. to 4 p.m.** *The per person rate is for the entire party, including photographer, assistants, and relatives of portrait clients.*

PORTRAIT PHOTOGRAPHY SESSION FEE (up to a 2 hour session**)

\$25: 1-5 people\$50: 6 to 10 people\$75: 11 to 15 people

PHOTOGRAPHY PASS SESSION FEE (up to a 2 hour session**)

Free: Up to 15 people, per shoot, per day \$25: for every additional group of 5 people. (Ex: 16-20 people = \$25, 21-25 people = \$50).

The photography pass is \$150 for the year. Photography pass holders has free entry for themself, and up to 14 clients and assistance. There is no limit to the number of photo shoots per year, but photographers and their clients are limited to one photoshoot per day.

****NOTE:** Photo sessions can be reserved up to two hours, but ALL photo sessions within two hours of closing must end at least 30 minutes prior to closing.

EVENING PHOTO SHOOT

Photography Pass Holders can reserve an evening photo shoot between 5 p.m. and 8 p.m., Tuesday - Saturday, for an additional \$50 per hour, maximum 2 hours. Reservations must be requested at least 2 weeks in advance and are subject to approval.

CANCELLATION POLICY: Edinburg Scenic Wetlands & World Birding Center and its facilities are subject to weather variations and temporary closures. The Center will attempt to reschedule should a session need to be canceled or refund photography fees. Shooting dates may be adjusted in the event of inclement weather; any changes must be agreed upon by our office. For more information, please contact (956) 381-9922.
