

Latest News on *Tiny Tots in Tiaras and Tuxedos*

I'm eagerly counting down to the Fall 2025 launch of *Tiny Tots in Tiaras and Tuxedos*!

Last month, my manuscript went through copyediting—polishing grammar, spelling, clarity, and flow. Now it's in the formatting stage, where details like fonts, photo placement, margins, and front matter (foreword, preface, table of contents, etc.) are being finalized. At the same time, the finishing touches are being added to the front and back covers.

Once that's done, the spine will be sized to match the exact page count—the final step before heading to print!

I'll admit, I once thought finishing the book was the hardest part. Turns out, the publishing process is far more involved (and longer!) than I imagined.

The good news?
Pre-orders should be opening in early October!
