Please call or stop by to register BOM's and Retreats. Payment for class **must** be made when you register. 24-hour cancellation notice is required for a refund to be applied to next class. BOM have different time frames and you are expected to pick them up on the scheduled date. No block returns or refunds for cancellations.

CLASS MATERIALS LIST

Bring your machine, extra needles, pins, scissors, thread, rotary cutter, rulers, a small cutting mat and seam rippers, anything that you may use at home. Fabrics can be purchased the day of the class or come by before class.

CLASS DESCRIPTION

January 29 – Masterpiece Block of the Month. Designed by the ladies from Wing and a Prayer Designs and batik fabric from Timeless Treasures is sure to be a favorite. These batik fabrics are rich in purple and blue color and amazing, put together in a stunning design. This quilt is 108 x108, is twelve months long and \$21.99 per month. It will be ready on the 3rd Saturday of each month.

February 12 – Puzzle Play BOM – Block #12 ready for pick up. We have full kits available.

February 19– Five Yard Challenge -We are starting early this year. This is one of my favorite things to do. Many of you know how this works, I will chose 5 fabrics and make a bundle of 1-yard cuts. You will make a quilt using the 5 fabric. You get to choose the pattern and can add any fabric you want. Must be at least a lap size (can be bigger if you want), be able to see all five fabrics, be completed by September 23, and brought to the shop to be displayed during the Mystery Harvest Shop Hop, September 28- October 1. Quilters will vote on a Viewer's Choice! It is amazing to see all the quilts hanging on the porch. Cost of the kit is \$49.95.

February 24-27 – Cabin Fever Retreat. No better way to spend these cold winter days than with a good long weekend of quilting. We will start at 9 am on Thursday and sew until 2 pm Sunday. We must follow state guidelines and wear a mask when moving about. If you feel ill, please call and cancel Bring your favorite chair if you want. Cost is \$30 for the weekend, does not include food or room. Food will be in the dining room with dinner only on Thursday. All 3 meals will be served Friday and Saturday. Sunday breakfast and lunch They will not offer room cleaning, but will supply fresh towels and linens. You will need to put them in a bag and set outside you door by noon. Call the front desk if you need coffee or other items. You will need all your sewing supplies, like rulers and cutters. We will make shop runs if you run out of anything. Small irons can create issues with the electric, so if we start throwing breakers, we will ask you to not use them. Call the shop to register, then call the Park for a room 800-325-0083. Rooms will not be available for Wednesday night. We may have to cancel at the last minutes if Covid numbers are high. Spots are limited.

March 12 – Easy 3 Yard Quilt. In conjunction with Boyd Co Extension Service, Boyd County Expo Center. Learn to make this easy and beautiful quilt. Perfect for beginners 8 am – noon. Call 606-739-5184 to register. Cost is \$25 and includes pattern book. You will need 3 matching but contrasting fabrics. 1½ yards of 2 fabrics and 1½ yards of 1.
