Camp is held each June on the Campus Beautiful of Eastern Kentucky University located in Richmond, KY. Our camp offers one and two week camping options for students grades 5th - 12th in band, orchestra, piano, vocal, and percussion.

Eligibility

Camp is open to all students grades 5-12 with at least one year experience on their instrument/voice.

Camping Options

RESIDENT CAMPER

Students stay on campus 24/7 through the duration of camp in one of our University Residence Halls. All meals are included for residential campers.

COMMUTER CAMPER

Students all daily musical activities but are free to go home at the end of the day. They may participate in any and all activities, but cannot spend the night. Lunch is the only meal offered to commuters.

MEALS

Meals are served at the Fresh Food Company in the ECU dining hall, where many nutritious and exciting options are available in all-you-can-eat buffet style. Stations include pizza, pasta, homestyle, vegetarian/vegan, sandwiches, and more.

Housing

Resident campers are in double rooms in one of our Residence Halls. Students are assigned rooms based upon roommate request or age.

Faculty

Camp faculty is composed of professional musicians, many of whom serve as professors at ECU. Additionally, we bring in guest artists, conductors, and clinicians from across the U.S. Years of professional experience combined with a low teacher to student ratio provide an optimum environment for students of all abilities.

Activities

In addition to a full 35+ hour week of musical instruction and activities, we also offer non-musical activities each afternoon.

Daily activities include:

Swimming, tennis, basketball, corn hole, board games, and video games

These are combined with many scheduled events such as camp picnic, camp dance movie nights, and pool parties.
