- All exhibitors and parents/guardians understand that if their animal tests positive
 for any substance that is not approved by the Food and drug administration (FDA)
 and/or the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) for slaughter animals
 destined for human consumption, the exhibitor shall forfeit their FLOOR
 PROCEEDS.
- 2. All decisions are final, and you will not have the right to appeal.
- 3. You further agree to not hold Limestone County Fair Association and/or any of it's associates liable for anything associated with this outcome.
- 4. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to find out what is and is not approved. You can research information on the FDA Website www.usda.gov and the USDA Website www.usda.gov

Please note, LCFA will not be conducting any of the residue testing. If testing is done, it will be conducted by the USDA and/ or FDA
