BREEDING SWINE

- 1. Breeding swine may be shown in market class. This determination must be made at validation and fees paid accordingly.
- 2. Any additional rules will be left to the committee in charge.

MARKET SWINE

- 1. All market swine must be on feed by the exhibitor and validated and ear-tagged on 12/11//21 preceding the show in the current school year.
- 2. Gilts may be shown in the market class.
- 3. Market swine will be weighed prior to the show.
- 4. Swine will be divided into the following breed divisions: Yorkshire, Hampshire, Duroc, Cross & Other Pure Breeds (OPB). Classes will then be set by weight. This will be done only with the weights on the day of the show.
- 5. All swine must be clipped prior to arrival on the show grounds.
- 6. All market swine must weigh 220 pounds (with a 5 pound grace) or they will be disqualified. Floor will pay up to 280lbs.
- 7. All animals must be clean prior to weighing and classification including validation tag.
- 8. Remove all tags except major validation tags prior to validation date.
