Due to a request from floor bidders, we will be implementing the following policy:

- 1. All exhibitors and parents/guardians understand that if their animal tests positive for any substance that is not approved by the Food and drug administration (FDA) and/or the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) for slaughter animals destined for human consumption, the exhibitor shall forfeit their FLOOR PROCEEDS.
- 2. All decisions are final, and you will not have the right to appeal.
- 3. You further agree to not hold Limestone County Fair Association and/or any of it's associates liable for anything associated with this outcome.
- 4. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to find out what is and is not approved. You can research information on the FDA Website <u>www.fda.gov</u> and the USDA Website <u>www.usda.gov</u>

Please note, LCFA will not be conducting any of the residue testing. If testing is done, it will be conducted by the USDA and/ or FDA
