I. **POLICY PURPOSE:**

The purpose of this policy is to define the minimum qualifications for a candidate for an office on the board of directors for Tarrant County (TCENA).

A. President Elect

1. Candidate must be a voting member in good standing in the national ENA and Texas ENA State Council and TCENA
2. Candidate must have current Registered Nurse (RN) licensure in the state of Texas
3. Candidate must have attended at least three TCENA chapter meetings in the past rolling 12 months and meet one of the following:
 - a. Served as an officer, past president or committee member or work group of TCENA in the past 2 years; or
 - b. Served as a TCENA delegate to the Texas General Assembly in the past year

B. Secretary, Secretary Elect, Treasurer, and Treasurer Elect

1. Candidate must be a voting member in good standing in the national ENA and Texas ENA State Council and TCENA
2. Candidate must have current Registered Nurse (RN) licensure in the state of Texas
3. Treasurer must have served 6 months as treasurer elect with mentorship from current term treasurer.
