## I. POLICY PURPOSE:

The purpose of this policy is to define the minimum qualifications for a candidate for an office on the board of directors for Tarrant County (TCENA).

## A. President Elect

- Candidate must be a voting member in good standing in the national ENA and Texas ENA State Council and TCENA
- 2. Candidate must have current Registered Nurse (RN) licensure in the state of Texas
- 3. Candidate must have attended at least three TCENA chapter meetings in the past rolling 12 months and meet one of the following:
  - a. Served as an officer, past president or committee member or work group of TCENA in the past 2 years; or
  - b. Served as a TCENA delegate to the Texas General Assembly in the past year
- B. Secretary, Secretary Elect, Treasurer, and Treasurer Elect
  - Candidate must be a voting member in good standing in the national ENA and Texas ENA State Council and TCENA
  - 2. Candidate must have current Registered Nurse (RN) licensure in the state of Texas
  - 3. Treasurer must have served 6 months as treasurer elect with mentorship from current term treasurer.
