Managing Your ENA Email Preferences

Overview

ENA members are automatically subscribed to receive email communications from the association. However, we have recently seen an increase in members unintentionally unsubscribing from ENA emails.

The purpose of this resource is to help explain how members may have accidentally unsubscribed from communications and provide guidance on how to opt back in to continue receiving important ENA updates, news and opportunities. Should you have any questions or need additional assistance, please contact marketing@ena.org.

Not Receiving Emails

Known reasons why members are not receiving emails from ENA:

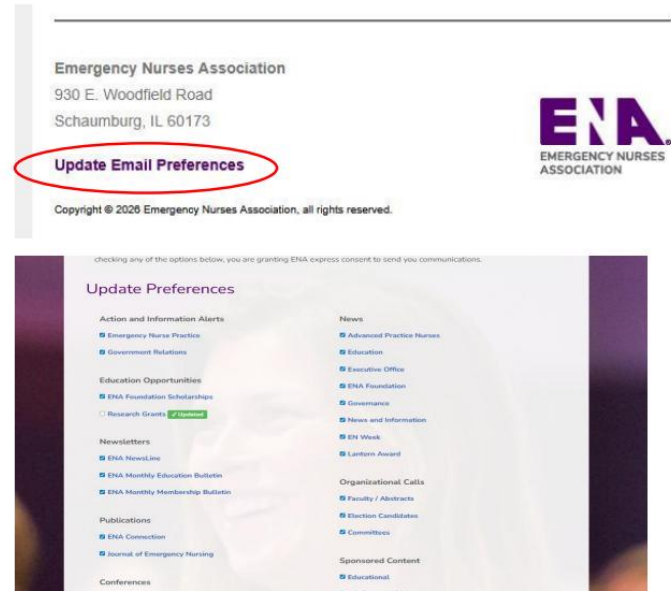
- They accidentally select unsubscribe at the top of their email once they click open (see screenshots below). They select "unsubscribe" at the top of their email to remove one type of message, not realizing they are unsubscribing from all ENA communications.
- The email is bounced back because it cannot be delivered due to mistyped emails or previous employer emails.
- Reporting ENA emails as spam.
- Their hospital emails have firewalls that don't allow ENA emails. ENA recommends utilizing your personal email address to avoid this.

How Members Can Opt In and Update Their Preferences

Opting in

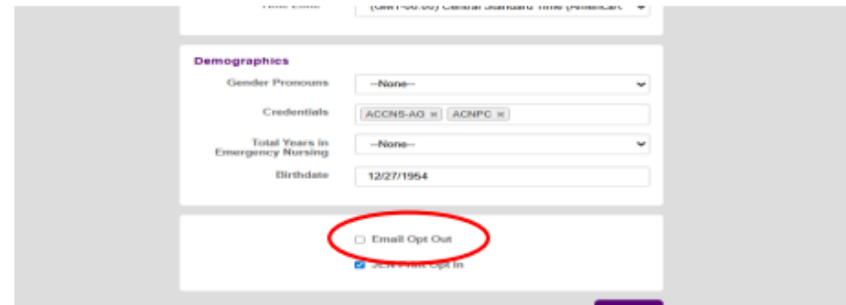
To opt back into ENA communications, members can:

- Find an old email and select "Update Email Preferences." Members are then brought directly to the Email Preference Center where they can update the emails they would like to receive. This is shown in the images below.
- If they can't find an old email or are still experiencing issues, members can contact marketing@ena.org.



Opting into Council Emails

Within a member's profile in the member portal, each member can make sure that the "Email Opt Out" is unchecked to receive emails from councils.



How Members Might Accidentally Opt Out of Emails Screenshots

Members can opt out by accidentally clicking "unsubscribe" at the top of their email (Yahoo, Gmail, Outlook, etc.) on a mobile device.

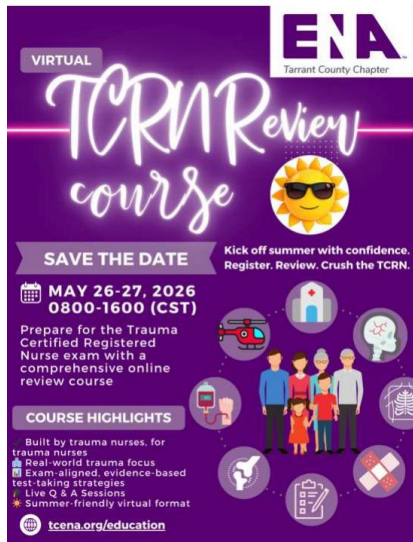

LOOK BEFORE YOU LOCK!

Follow these tips to ensure you never leave your child alone in a car.



Always check the back seat before locking the car.



Secure something you need at your destination in the back seat, like your cell phone, employee badge or handbag.



Keep a stuffed animal in the child's car seat. Place it on the front passenger seat as a reminder when the child is in the back seat.



Create a check-in system with your partner or caregiver to confirm that drop-off was made.



Use technology, like rear seat reminders, that alerts drivers to check the back seat.



Ask your babysitter or childcare provider to call you if your child hasn't arrived as scheduled.

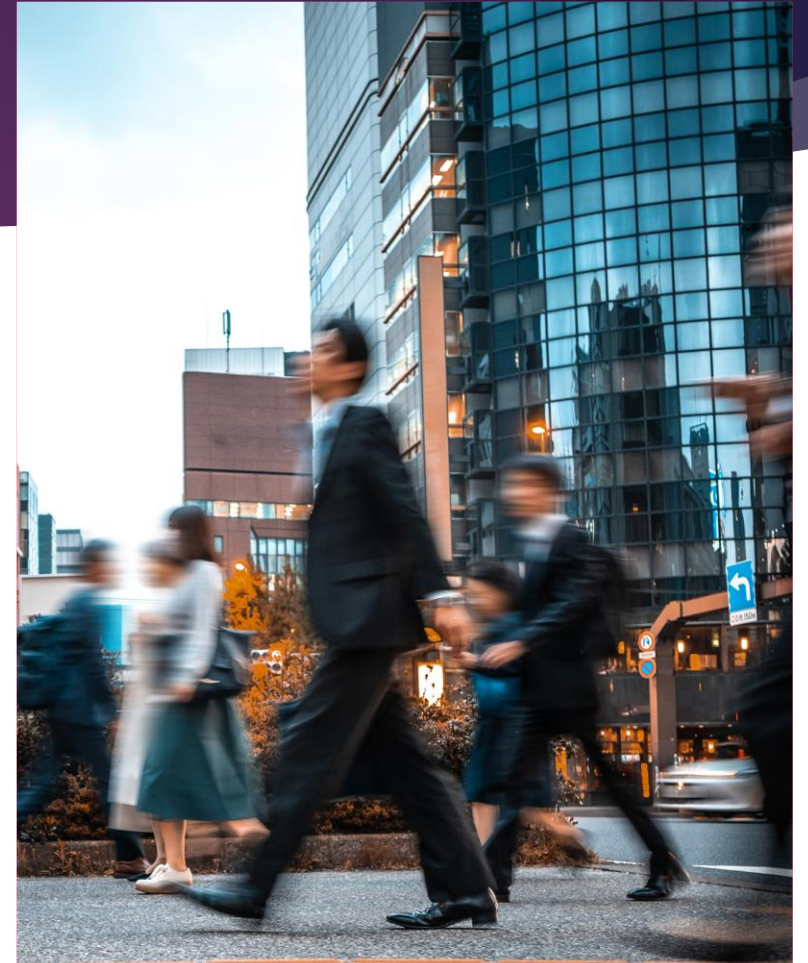

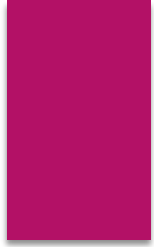
