# 2. Personalized Communication and Knowledge Management

A core function of an AI change coach is to provide personalized and accessible information.

• JPMorgan Chase: JPMorgan Chase has been a leader in using AI across its organization. They have over 300 AI use cases in production, spanning areas like risk, marketing, and customer experience.<sup>6</sup> While not a public "change coach" case study, their use of AI for internal communication and data analysis demonstrates the foundational technology. An AI system that can handle complex queries and summarize large reports (a common use case for them) is the same technology that can be adapted to answer employee questions about a change initiative. This enhances transparency and makes information more readily available.

 Petrobras: The Brazilian oil and gas company Petrobras created "Chat Petrobras" using Azure OpenAI. This AI tool is used by over 110,000 employees to streamline workflows,



reduce manual tasks, and summarize reports. This is a perfect example of an Al acting as a virtual assistant that can be easily repurposed as a change coach. It reduces the time employees spend on routine tasks, freeing them up to focus on learning and adapting to new ways of working.
