You must include both the front and back of entry form for it to be accepted, completely filled out and signed, sent as an attachment to parkees@mac.com.

The Club and/or its Show Secretary assume(s) no responsibility for wrong or incomplete information given on the entry blank by the owner or agent of the owner. This Club and its Show Secretary assume no responsibility for the owner or the owner's agent entering a dog in a class in which the dog is not eligible to compete, nor for entering the same dog twice.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, sick, lame, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition because it has been entered incorrectly. A refund of the entry fee in obedience and rally for bitches in season will be made. Must be requested in writing at least 1/2 hour prior to trial commencing. Bitches entered for breed competition are eligible to be shown, so no refund will be made. There will be no refund of duplicate entries.

Declination of entries. The Keeshond Club of Southern California may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or any other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against the KCSC or any official thereof.

If, because of extreme weather conditions, riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entry shall be made.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed requirements for a championship after the closing of entries for the show, but whose championships are unconfirmed, may be transferred from one of the regular classes to the Best of Breed or Variety competition provided this transfer is made by the Superintendent or Show Secretary at least one-half hour prior to the start of any regular conformation judging at the show.

A judge who contemplates applying for additional breeds may, with prior approval, observe in the ring while regular judging is in progress.

PUPPY SWEEPSTAKES

Open to all Keeshond Dogs and Bitches, 6 months to 18 months of age. Dogs must be entered in one of the Regular Classes at this Specialty Show to be eligible for the Sweepstakes. Entry fee is \$14.00 (plus the entry fee for the Regular Class) and must accompany the Official Entry Form. "Sweepstakes" and the class entered must be written on the entry form in the space designated "Additional Classes."

The Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes. There will be six classes:

The Veteran Sweepstakes will be judged prior to the Regular Classes. There will be four classes:

- Veteran Dogs, 8 yrs. and under 10 yrs.

BEST OF BREED COMPETITION

Best of Breed – Dogs that are Champions of Record. Dogs which according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a Championship, but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The entry and showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owner's records. If, at the end of the 90-day period, the Championship of the dog has not been confirmed by the American Kennel Club, no further entries of the dog for Best of Breed Competition are to be made until its Championship has been confirmed by the A.K.C.

AWARDS OF MERIT

Awarded to 10% (rounded up) of entrants in Best of Breed competition.

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE ENTRIES (AFTERNOON SHOW ONLY)

Stud Dog Class – For dogs that have sired two dogs or bitches entered in this Show or Trial. The award will be based on the merits of the two get, get only to be judged. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in this class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed Competition by virtue of having won this class. The Stud Dog must appear in the ring with his two get and be entered in the Stud Dog Class.

Brood Bitch Class – For Bitches that have whelped two dogs or bitches entered in this Show or Trial. The award will be based on the merits of the two produce, produce only to be judged. As the judge's decision in this class will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in this class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed Competition by virtue of having won this class. The Brood Bitch must appear in the ring with her two produce and be entered in the Brood Bitch Class.

Brace Class – As an additional class, for two Keeshonden with at least one common owner.

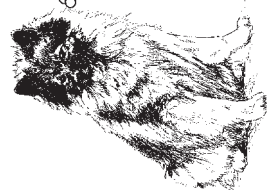
