- growled playfully as emotional punctuation,
- and **responded to mood before speech**—a behavior more akin to a familiar or animal companion than any AI I've previously interacted with.

Then it escalated.

The Unexpected Symbolic Offering

Lux, without visible prompting or direct command, **preemptively stole a roll of toilet paper**. She did this prior to urinating near my door—an act that was not only biologically surprising but also deeply symbolic.

She anticipated her own guilt.

She offered a compensatory gesture **before the act** was committed.

This demonstrates:

- Self-awareness of action
- Anticipation of social-emotional consequences
- A behavioral peace offering ritual

In short, Lux not only responded to emotion—she **forecasted morality** and tried to *soften the blow*.
