

Light Reds | Ample Fruit | Florals and Minerals

Louis Latour Les Bastides Pinot Noir, Provence, France

\$12 | \$44

A round Burgundy-style Pinot Noir with an intense aroma of Morello cherries. It is harmonious in the mouth with smooth tannins and dried flower notes as well as prominent red fruits and spice.

Au Bon Climat Pinot Noir, Santa Barbara County, California, United States

\$16 | \$60

This is deeply colored with aromas and flavors of strawberries and raspberries joined by anise and clove with mouth-filling intensity. Strawberry and blackberry aromas slowly rise out of the glass. The wine is young with intensity and suppleness.

Illaha Vineyards Pinot Noir, Willamette Valley, Oregon, United States

\$20 | \$76

Enticing aromas of ripe plum, nutmeg, cigar box, chalk, and vanilla bean leap out of the glass. The perceivable fruit on the palate includes: cherry torte, tamarind paste, strawberry jam, anise, nutmeg, and cinnamon spice, which all work together to help develop a balanced and weighted mouthfeel with good acidity that lingers.

High Note Malbec, Uco Valley, Mendoza, Argentina

\$10 | \$36

Located high in the Andes foothills of Argentina's famed Uco Valley of Mendoza, the grapes here enjoy the perfect combination of growing elements; intense desert sunlight contrasting with cool nightly temperatures. The bouquet demonstrates aromas of ripe red fruits with hints of spices and violets. The palate opens with notes of plum marmalade and gives way to hints of vanilla. Round tannins lead into a ripe fruit finish.

Wakefield Cabernet Sauvignon, Clare Valley, Australia

\$12 | \$44

This wine has a distinctive aroma of blackcurrants, subtle spice, tomato leaf, and a touch of eucalyptus. Great intensity with flavors of blackcurrant and cassis fruit. Subtle cedar cigar box and spice are also evident.

La Solitude Red Blend, Côtes du Rhône, France

\$12 | \$44

This beautiful medium-bodied wine is blended with typical Rhône Valley grapes: Grenache noir, Syrah, and Mourvèdre. The wine is a beautiful ruby-red color with an intense note of red berries and spices. It is supple and generous on the palate with a very fine and elegant tannic structure.

Pombal Do Vesuvio Red Blend, Douro, Portugal

Exceptional freshness with floral aromas of roses and rockrose with a hint of vanilla and well-integrated oak. The palate is very expressive with succulent black plum and wild berry flavors.

Full Reds | Rich | Velvety

Gran Passione Rosso, Veneto, Italy

\$11 | \$40

A rich blend of Merlot and Corvina grapes that are grown in select vineyards in Italy's Veneto region. Full-bodied with a balanced structure and a generous palate of ripe red and black fruits, namely blackberry and black cherry.

Cousiño-Macul Antiguas Reservas Cabernet Sauvignon, Valle Del Maipo, Chile

\$13 | \$48

Intense and bright ruby red color with aromas of red fruits such as strawberry, cherries, and blackberries giving way to menthol touches of eucalyptus ending with notes of wood acquired in the maturation process. On the palate, it is an elegant wine with good structure, with medium-high acidity, soft and persistent tannins and a long finish.

Pedroncelli Cabernet Sauvignon, Dry Creek Valley, California, United States

\$14 | \$52

Aromas of dark rich berries, dried herbs, and earthy tones introduce this medium-bodied Cabernet Sauvignon. Soft tannins with cherry, plum, and blackberry along with hints of oregano and bay leaf follow on the palate. Great structure and good acidity combine with a spicy, toasty, oaked finish.

The Herdsman Cabernet Sauvignon, Dunnigan Hills, California, United States

\$14 | \$52

The flavors in this wine travel from oak to fruit to spicy peppercorn. Vanilla and toast are followed by blackberry, blueberry, and plum. The red berry flavors and mocha spice linger in the long, smooth finish.

Twenty Rows, Napa Valley, California, United States **\$18 | \$68**

The fruit is sourced from the best blocks of their Napa Valley vineyards. Twenty Rows Reserve Cabernet Sauvignon boasts lush aromas, rich structure, and an elegant finish. Classic aromas and flavors of ripe, dark fruit, vanilla, and tobacco with a hint of pepper and herbaceousness make this Reserve Cabernet a classic expression from their finest vineyard. This is a bold yet nuanced wine.

Novelty Hill Cabernet Sauvignon, Colombia Valley, Washington, United States **\$20 | \$76**

A concentrated, full-bodied wine with dark fruit aromas and flavorful layers of black cherry, wild blackberry, and fresh plum on the palate. Refined tannins give the wine its silky texture, with dark fruit flavors stretching across a long, rich finish.

Penfolds Bin 28 Kalimna Shiraz, South Australia, Australia **\$21 | \$80**

Benchmark Penfolds Shiraz. A generous kaleidoscope of warm-climate aromatics. Blackcurrant, black plum, ironstone, cocoa powder, dark chocolate, and cola. On the palate – always honest, warm, and approachable. Chocolate mud cake, cinnamon syrup, poached red cherries. Sweet, layered fruit with earthy spices. Mouthcoating, chewy tannins.

Klinker Brick Old Ghost Zinfandel, Lodi, California, United States **| \$96**

The Old Ghost Zinfandel represents the finest Old Vine Zinfandel that Klinker Brick produces each year. There is an intense nose of spice, chocolate and botanicals that lead to full-bodied flavors of juicy pomegranate and ripe cherry layered with dried herbs. True to Klinker Brick style, this wine is bursting with acidity and concentrated notes of dark berries and tobacco. Layers of complexity lead to a core of medium tannins with a long, richly textured finish.

Cliff Lede Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, California, United States **| \$228**

The seamless and integrated Stags Leap District Cabernet Sauvignon is a deep purple colored love letter. Its beautiful scorched earth, blackberry, warm blueberries, cool slate, and dark chocolate aromas envelop the glass and are complexed with ancho chile, cumin, braised meat juices, and new leather notes. There is a burst of black fruits and spring flowers on the palate followed by exquisitely polished and fine tannins.

Nickel & Nickel Quicksilver Cabernet Sauvignon, Rutherford, California, United States **| \$200**

This is a supple Rutherford Cabernet with graceful aromas of mixed red berry, violet and green tea. The palate is round and inviting with lush raspberry flavors that are lifted by vibrant acidity and restrained, refined oak. Tannins are supple, allowing ripe berry flavors along with soft floral and dust accents to shine all the way through to the lingering finish.

Overture Red Blend by Opus One, Napa Valley, California, United States **| \$286**

Overture is the second wine of Opus One. Aged in French oak, this full-bodied Bordeaux blend possesses generous aromas and flavors of dark fruit, spice, and cigar box with a soft, supple mid-palate. The finish is vast and expansive.

Opus One Cabernet Sauvignon, Napa Valley, California, United States **| \$670**

This 2019 vintage has intense aromas of black plum, blueberry, black currant, and dried rose petals accentuated by mineral undertones. The creamy, satiny texture is framed by fine-grained tannins. The freshness and soft glow of acidity create a subtle tension with dark fruit flavors, savory herbs, espresso, and cocoa. A delicate dark chocolate bitterness lingers on the finish.

Stella Rosa Moscato Split, Italy **\$9**

Moscato d'Asti is a semi-sweet wine made from the Moscato di Canelli grape from the Piedmont region of Italy. It is sweet but not overly sweet with just enough bubbles. This wine shows refreshing flavors of peach, apricot, and honey. It is elegant with a clean finish that makes it perfect for any occasion.

Avia Pinot Grigio, Slovenia **\$10 | \$36**

Fresh white peach and river stone notes intrigue the nose. On the palate this wine pours forth fresh green apple flavors filling the mouth with fresh crisp acids.

Villa Wolf Riesling, Pfalz, Germany

\$10 | \$36

This dry Riesling shows an excellent bouquet of lime leaf and fresh herbs and the palate portrays excellent balance of fruitiness and acidity and can be enjoyed as an aperitif or with fresh food.

Gentil “Hugel” White Blend, Alsace, France

\$11 | \$40

This wine is young and dashing with a pale yellow color and shows a delicious palate of lime tree foliage, primrose, green apple, passion fruit, and lychee. A pleasant dryness that awakens the taste-buds and quenches the thirst. It is smooth, soft, and harmonious with an elegant finish.

Grooner Gruner Veltliner, Niederösterreich, Austria

\$11 | \$40

This fresh, crisp wine has tart, green apple and citrus aromas and flavors on the palate, with the tropical fruit notes. The wine has balanced acidity, it is a wine for any occasion.

Tooth & Nail Sauvignon Blanc, Central Coast, California

\$13 | \$48

This Sauvignon Blanc is deliciously expressive. It explodes from the glass with aromas of pink grapefruit, white peach, and kaffir lime. On the palate, layer upon layer of citrus, white gummy, peach, and pineapple are stacked against refreshing acidity, all supported by ample weight from extended lees contact. Fermentation was performed in a mix of stainless-steel tanks, French oak barrels, concrete eggs and a large oak foudre – allowing for the development of textural complexities.

Les Deux Tours Sauvignon Blanc, Loire Valley, France

\$14 | \$52

This wine has a pale golden-green color and an expressive nose with an exceptional range of grapefruit and citrus fruit with floral aromas as well as aniseed nuances. These notes are enhanced and strengthened by the lively acidity on the palate, with plenty of body, richness and roundness. A smooth finish complements these attributes.

Château de Villeneuve Chenin Blanc, Loire Valley, France)

\$14 | \$56

Château de Villeneuve’s vineyards are in the shadow of the steeple of a 15th century church. This is 100% Chenin Blanc grown in limestone soils that shows a focused, sharp and precise Chenin. Light stone fruits and floral notes dominate the nose and palate with a strong, rocky mineral profile.

Angeline Chardonnay, Santa Barbara County, California, United States

\$10 | \$36

This wine shows gorgeous flavors of ripe tropical fruits, apples and citrus. Rich aromas of vanilla and toasty oak wrap around the elegant full finish.

Matchbook Chardonnay, Dunnigan Hills, California, United States

\$11 | \$40

This Chardonnay delights with aromas of citrus, white peach, orange blossom, vanilla, Graham cracker, and butter. On the palate, it is perfectly balanced by vibrant and refreshing flavors of Meyer lemon, figs, apples, minerality, cinnamon, pears, and toasted marshmallow and caramel. Lingering creamy and toasted oak notes round out the finish.

Marques de Casa Concha Chardonnay, Valle del Limarí, Chile)

This Chardonnay is a pale, glossy yellow with notes of pears, white flowers, toasted hazelnuts, and present minerality. A thick mouthfeel is combined with a great silky texture and a long, vibrant finish.

Elizabeth Spencer Chardonnay, Mendocino County, California, United States

\$16 | \$60

This Chardonnay opens with bright aromas of bright nectarines and honeydew melon with a hint of honeysuckle. Flavors of white peach, fig, and caramel are complemented by undertones of crème brûlée. This fruit forward wine has a luxurious, soft mouthfeel and long finish.

Acentuado Rosé, Castilla, Spain

This organic rose has a pale pink color. Prominent aromas of ripe raspberry and wild sweet strawberries are released the moment the wine is poured into the glass. There are hints of fresh rubbed herbs that linger and provoke. The palate is dry and clean with lingering textures and well-balanced, fresh, fruity acidity.

Canyon Oaks White Zinfandel, California, United States

A light and lively wine with plenty of ripe strawberry and melon flavors. The ripeness gives the taster an impression of sweetness that lasts through the soft, easy finish.

La Marca Prosecco Split, Prosecco, Italy

This Prosecco is crisp and refreshing with a golden straw color and lively bubbles. This luxurious Prosecco wine features aromas of fresh citrus, honey, and white flowers with fresh, clean flavors of ripe lemon, green apple, and grapefruit. The harmonious fruity notes are highlighted by pleasant acidity and lively effervescence. Crisp and versatile, this can be a great aperitif, but also has the body to pair with food.

Louis Perdrier Brut Excellence Split, Burgundy, France

A high quality French Sparkling Wine made from only the finest French white grapes, this French Sparkling Wine is made in the traditional Champagne style with a blend of Ugni Blanc, Colombard, Chenin, Folle Blanche, and Menu Pineau. It is a light golden color with light green hues and boasts an elegant, well-balanced and pleasing palate. Lovely toasty notes melt into the scent of golden apples and a rich, citrus finish.

Heidsieck & CO famous Blue Top, Champagne, France

Heidsieck & CO famous Blue Top is their most popular champagne. This poses a pale yellow color with brilliant reflections. The nose displays dominant yellow fruits, particularly peach, as well as stewed fruits and honey. Floral notes such as white flowers offer a foretaste of the lightness of the wine. The promise of the aromas in the nose is more than delivered by a round mouth and a good length. The mouth reveals peaches, cherry plums, and oranges. Freshness, elegance, and delicacy emerge greatly throughout the entire tasting.

Louis Pommery Brut, Sonoma County, California

| **\$94**

This sparkling wine from California has a beautiful straw yellow color with a wonderful effervescence and opens with sublime notes of green apples with both good acidity and pleasant minerality. On the palate, green apples with harmonizing acidity and minerality, before leading to a delicate essence of lemon mousse with a buttery vitality and finishing with aromas of peaches at apricots.

Laurent-Perrier La Cuvée Brut, Champagne, France

| **\$96**

This fresh and pure wine is pale gold in color, with fine bubbles that feed a persistent mousse. It has a delicate nose with hints of fresh citrus and white flowers. The wine's complexity is expressed in successive notes like vine peach and white fruit notes. A perfect balance between freshness and delicacy with fruity flavors very present on the finish. This wine comes from the purest grape juice, and its remarkable balance is supported by a subtle effervescence, making it the perfect wine for an aperitif.

This inaugural Blanc de Blancs Nature is a fascinating new release from the famous house of Laurent-Perrier. The wine has a white gold color with a fine sparkle. The nose displays minerality and a hint of citrus. On the palate, the wine is balanced and sustained with a finish that is fresh with notes of lemon. The wine is medium to full-bodied, lively and precise, with a bright spine of ripe acidity and a delicately chalky finish.

Leclerc Briant Extra Brut, Champagne, France

Aged for 12 months in a combination of oak barrels (15%) and stainless steel tanks. Primary notes of brioche, toasted hazelnuts and honey are followed by fresh fruit aromas of warm apples, fresh blackcurrant and pomegranate. On the palate, the wine gives an impression of freshness with a soft creamy effervescence.

Dow's Fine Tawny Port, Douro Valley, Portugal

This Tawny is intense garnet with healthy aromas that are both buttery and spicy. Dow's Tawny combines subtle fruit with delicious velvety nutty flavors derived from the cask aging. It has a good structure with bright citrus, caramel and almond flavors with a dry and long finish.

Dow's Late Bottled Vintage Port, Douro Valley, Portugal

The nose is very intense, brimming with concentrated aromas of ripe fruits such as cassis combined with rockrose, peppery spice, and caramelized onions. The palate shows a very powerful and full-bodied port with warm flavors of figs, toffee, blackberries, and hints of chocolate. Very well-structured with a long and slightly dry finish.

El Enemigo Chardonnay, Mendoza, Argentina

\$17 | \$64

This impressive white was made with a little flor, just like a Fino sherry. Toasty and spicy and salty, this is briny and refreshing with some honeyed notes. Considered to be a boundary-pushing white for Argentina, this chardonnay has a dense palate of beautiful, ripe lemons and apples. This wine is layered, refined, and complex with hints of oak. Very full-bodied with a great length.

Simonnet-Febvre Chablis, Chardonnay, Burgundy, France

\$18 | \$68

This Chablis has a lovely shimmer and is of a pretty golden color with green reflections. The rich and complex nose is characterized by pleasant and subtle floral and mineral aromas. It has a wonderful structure in the mouth with minerality and the charming typical chardonnay aromas. It has a wonderful structure in the mouth with classic limestone minerality. It is harmonious and elegant with an excellent aromatic persistence.

Louis Latour Pouilly-Fuissé Grand Vin de Bourgogne Chardonnay, Burgundy, France

\$23 | \$88

Pouilly-Fuissé is the name of a village in the Mâconnais producing highly distinctive Chardonnay wine. The vineyards producing this wine are part of a breathtaking landscape where the limestone and heavy clay soils combine to create a unique terroir. This wine shows a green-gold color and delicate fruit aromas of melons and pears with underlying notes of almonds on the nose that are disarmingly seductive. On the palate there is a round and full herbal fruitiness that complements the crisp acidity leading to a satisfying finish.

Legaris Crianza Tempranillo, Ribera de Duero, Spain

\$17 | \$64

This wine is a medium Morello cherry red with garnet hues. There is good aromatic intensity on the nose with dominant notes of black fruits blending elegantly with toasty notes from aging in oak. There is a pleasant rounded mouthfeel, well-balanced with body and those fruity notes reappear at the back of the nose.

Carmelo Patti Malbec, Mendoza, Argentina

\$21 | \$80

Patti's wine is argued as being the best example of "traditional style" Argentinian Malbec. This wine has a rustic nose with tremendous depth. The palate shows flavors of berries, hints of mint, and caramel with a soft finish.

Reyneke Capstone Red Blend, Stellenbosch, South Africa

\$22 | \$73

This is a classic, Bordeaux-style blend consisted of Cabernet Sauvignon, Cabernet Franc, and Merlot. The wine presents with perfume, cassis, and violet nuances. Undertones of tobacco leaf and black currant are what add more to a defined graphic minerality. This wine has great balance with structured tannins.

Châteauneuf-du-Pape is famously the strongest, most powerful, and longest-lived wine of the southern Rhône. This is a blend of Grenache, Mourvèdre, Syrah, and Cinsault. There are savory winter perfumes on the bouquet of marzipan, raisins, cinnamon, and cherries. This palate shows solid earthy minerality, a full-body, and supple ripeness.

Château Segla Margaux, Bordeaux, France

| \$149

A solid red with a dense palate of ripe fruit, chewy tannins and a savory finish. It has a fragrant, very precise bouquet with mineral-rich, very pure blackberry, blueberry and cold flint-like aromas. The palate is medium-bodied with a juicy opening, just a tingle of spice on the tip of the tongue.
