2019 VISUAL ARTS SCHOLARSHIP

The North Augusta Artists Guild's Visual Arts Scholarship of \$500 is awarded annually to a graduating senior who is pursuing a major or minor college degree in the visual arts, defined as drawing, painting, sculpture, mixed media, photography, graphic arts, and art education. The North Augusta Artists Guild was initiated in 2002 as a group of local citizens who support artists and art organizations by sponsoring projects that enhance the arts in the North Augusta community as well as in the CSRA. The Visual Arts Scholarship is funded by members of the Artists Guild.

The scholarship applicant must reside in Aiken or Edgefield counties and attend high school (North Augusta High School, Fox Creek High School, Strom Thurmond High School, Aiken High School, public, private, and charter or home school). He/she must demonstrate excellence in the visual arts. Eligible applicants must intend to enroll in an accredited college, university, or other institution of formal education in the fall of 2019.

All applications are reviewed by a Scholarship Committee comprised of North Augusta Artists Guild members. An application is also available through the North Augusta Artists Guild's website at www.northaugustaartistsguild.com. **Application deadline is the last Friday in March, March 29, 2019. Applications or letters of recommendation postmarked after March 29, 2019 will not be accepted.** The Visual Arts Scholarship winner will be announced at the May 7 meeting of the North Augusta Artists Guild held at 7 PM at the North Augusta Community Center.

 - Demonstrated willingness to work toward improvement
 - Some estimation of potential level of achievement
3. A list of awards, activities on and off campus, volunteer & community activities.
4. Current transcript from applicant's high school guidance office.
5. Letter of acceptance from an accredited college, university or other institution of formal training.
6. **Visual Arts:** Work sample that demonstrates the applicant's abilities. A CD with 3-6 original pieces showcasing the applicant's talent. The CD may contain work from more than one medium. Background information required on each piece of art includes the following:
 - Title.
 - Size.
 - Medium used.
 - Date completed.
