There are no sales, just a chance to share your art.



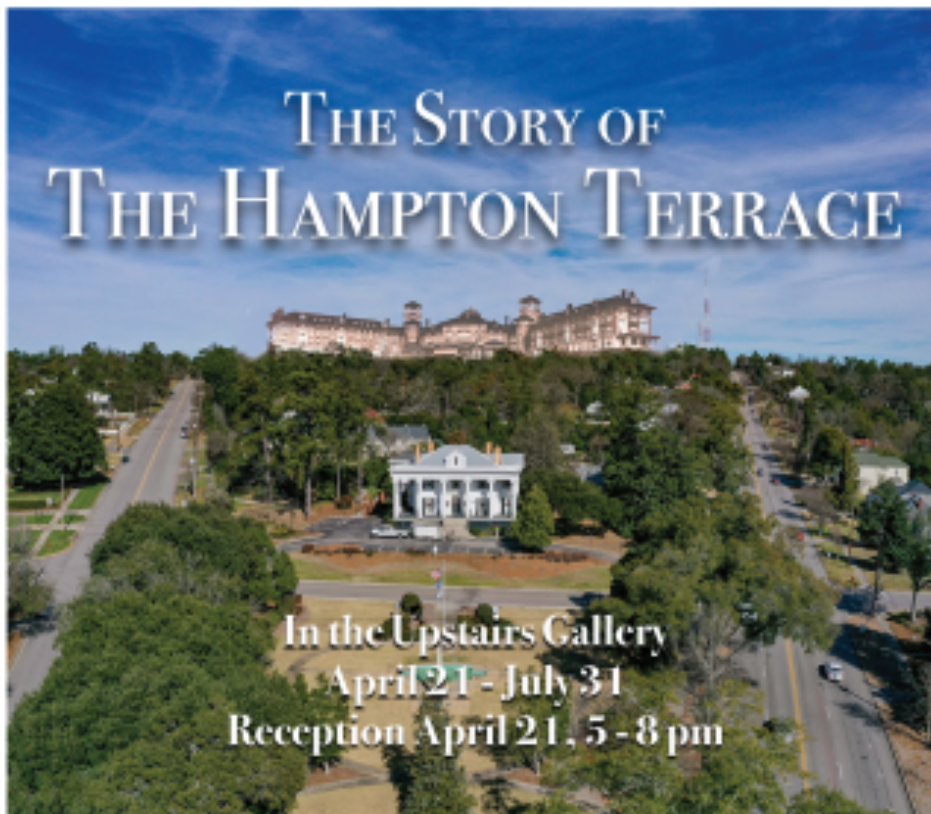
