POOL INFORMATION-

 All children seven years old and younger are required to stay within arm reach of an individual over the age of 16 and wear a lifejacket. The aquatics department has a selection of life jackets that the day camps can use during their pool times.



- Children eight years and older will have the opportunity to complete a swim test at the beginning of each camp week which will be supervised by an on duty lifeguard. If they pass, they will be able to swim without a lifejacket, if they are unsuccessful they will require the use of a lifejacket. They can attempt the swim test once a week, and a master list will be maintained throughout the summer.
- The swim test consists of jumping into the deep end, then without touching the wall or using an aid, treading water for 60 seconds with their jaw line, nose, and ears out of the water, then without touching the wall or an aid, front crawl 25 meters with their head in the water and breathing to the side.
- Due to the ratios required within the pool, campers must participate during the swim periods, unless a medical reason is present. We do not have the staff available for alternate activities during these times.

ZERO TOLERANCE

Our zero tolerance policy exists to protect our campers and leaders against violence, bullying, name calling, teasing, etc. At Camp JCC we do not want to see any camper dismissed for behavioral reasons. We make every effort to work with day campers and their families, allowing them the opportunity to correct their mistakes when they are misbehaving. However, we do have a zero tolerance policy for campers committing excessive verbal or physical abuse towards campers or leaders. This behavior would include: hitting, punching, kicking, or other forms of fighting, verbal threats of violence, and excessive name calling and swearing. Furthermore, any camper caught stealing or damaging another person's property will also be subject to our zero tolerance policy. These previously mentioned behaviors will not be tolerated and may result in expulsion for the remainder of the camp session.

- Full day camps run from 9AM to 4PM and include a one-hour lunch break. Mini camps run from 9AM to 12PM. Specialized half day camps run from 9AM to 12PM or 1 to 4PM. Extended camps run from 9AM to 1PM or 12 to 4PM. Pre-care is 8 to 9AM and post-care is 4 to 5:30PM. Pre- and post-care are both registered programs.
- Online registration is available at mycalgaryjcc.com starting May 1, 2024. If registration is done online, the registration form MUST be emailed to camp@cjcc.ca. Registration can also be done in person at the JCC Customer Service Desk by completing the form.
- 3. Early bird discount is available for mini, junior, general, and sports camps. It does not apply to specialized camps, pre-care, post-care, or the lunch option.
- 4. Payment plans are available upon request. All fees must be paid prior to June 1, 2024. Please set up a payment schedule with the JCC Customer Service Desk.
- 5. If withdrawing from a camp session, a minimum of five business days written notice must be provided to the Camp Director. No refund will be provided with less than five days notice. A ^{\$}25 processing fee will be charged to each week withdrawal or change.
- 6. There will be a ^{\$}10 administration fee charged for any changes requested after the registration form has been submitted. Purchasing of additional weeks will not be subject to penalty.
- 7. If a camper withdraws during the camp session, no refund will be given.
- 8. No refunds will be given for absences during camp session.
- Each camp group requires a minimum number of campers to operate. Camper groups may be blended to ensure requirements are met, or camp may be cancelled.
- 10. Member prices are not available for children of families holding individual or senior memberships. Member prices are available with a valid family and single parent membership for the week they are attending.
- 11. Please ensure that you bring a hat, bathing suit, towel, sunscreen, snacks (minimum two snacks are required to be sent each day) and a labeled water bottle every day.
- 12. On Tuesdays prior to the start of each week, parents will be emailed a detailed package regarding their child's upcoming camp. If you do not receive this by Thursday, please send an email to camp@cjcc.ca.
- 13. Lunch must be brought from home, unless registered for the lunch option.
- 14. We are allergy and kosher sensitive. If you are uncertain as to what foods are acceptable, contact the JCC at camp@cjcc.ca for more information.
