

RULES FOR CIRCULATING NOMINATION PAPERS (PLEASE FOLLOW EXACTLY)

1. Do not circulate nomination papers until **Thursday, December 1, 2022**. Any Elector signatures dated prior to December 1 will be disqualified.
2. You may make extra copies of the blank nomination form but should not alter it any way.
3. All individuals who sign must be qualified to vote in the State of Wisconsin in that they are at least 18 years of age.
4. All individuals must print and sign their names, fill in their complete address and municipality of residence (no P.O. Box addresses), and date their signature. If any portion of the line is left blank, the signature is disqualified. State law requires both printed and signed names.
5. All individuals must list the exact, specific municipality of their physical residence. For example, use the Village of Menomonee Falls, not Menomonee Falls. Also, circulators must list their specific municipality on the certification on the bottom of the page.
6. Do not use abbreviations for municipalities.
7. The person circulating this document for signatures must be at least 18 years old and qualified to vote.
8. The person circulating this document must personally present this document for signature. You may not leave it unattended on a counter or bulletin board.
9. The person circulating must **complete and sign** the Certification of Circulator at the bottom of the nomination paper. The Certification of Circulator must be completed, so if you are the only elector on the sheet, please complete the Certification of Circulator prior to returning the nomination paper to Jennifer for Justice. **NOTE: Notarization of paper is not required.**
10. Please return completed nomination papers signed by the person circulating it no later than **Monday, December 21, 2022** to: Jennifer for Justice, P.O. Box 587, Hartland, WI 53029. If you cannot return a full sheet, please return a partial sheet. Every signature helps.
