- He will not judge by what he sees or hears with his physical ears  
Unlike many judges today, Jesus makes perfect assessments as a righteous Judge, based on the wisdom of God.

There are many spirits at work today but there is only one HOLY SPIRIT. Those two words give us better understanding of his character.

**HOLY** He is pure, righteous and fire, grieved by any sin against God or his purposes.  
Full of light, love, joy, peace, goodness, gentleness, faithfulness, wisdom.

**SPIRIT** He is like the wind, always moving in power. To resist his activity is to quench him. Jesus was led by the Holy Spirit. Follow the leader.
