The Greatest Heritage Jesus had the greatest family background one could ever imagine. We are not talking about Joseph and Mary, but the original family of Father, Son and Holy Spirit. It was a place of glory, complete unity and perfect love - John 17:5, 11, 24.

Some teach that Jesus was 'born again' after dying spiritually, based on Colossians 1:18 where it says that Jesus is the 'first born from the dead'. The term born again there means Jesus was first in rank.
