THE PRINCIPLE OF GREATNESS

Jesus Christ is the greatest person that ever lived and is an expert in all phases of life. He revealed to his disciples what makes a person great based on God's kingdom values, which are contrary to this world system.

- 'Whoever <u>practices and teaches</u> these commands will be called <u>great</u> in the kingdom of heaven.' Matthew 5:19b (Jesus referred to the Sermon on the Mount teachings)
- Whoever <u>humbles himself</u> like this child is the <u>greatest</u> in the kingdom of heaven.' Matthew 18:4.

The kings of the Gentiles lorded themselves over their populous, but Jesus proclaimed:

• 'You are not to be like that. Instead, the greatest among you should be like the youngest and the one who rules like the one who serves.' - Luke 22:26

Jesus was a **servant-king** who washed his disciples feet - John 13:14-17. How unlike this are self-absorbed Kings, Presidents. Prime Ministers, politicians and dictators, that instead of serving the people, they take advantage of them.. They shower luxury and privileges upon themselves at the expense of the people they are meant to serve. In their pride they, exalt themselves with their titles, honors and riches. Pastors are not immune from this. Instead of feeding the sheep, they fleece them and feed off of them.

'Son of Man, prophesy against the shepherds of Israel; prophesy and say to them: This is what The Sovereign Lord says: Woe to the shepherds of Israel who <u>only take care of themselves!</u> Should you not take care of the flock! You eat the curds, clothe yourselves with the wool and slaughter the choice of animals, but you do not take care of the flock. You have not strengthened the weak or healed the sick or bound up the injured. You have not brought back the strays or searched for the lost. You have ruled them harshly and brutally. So they were scattered because there was no shepherd, and then they were scattered they became food for all the wild animals. My sheep wandered over all the mountains and on every high hill. They were scattered over the whole earth, and no one searched or looked for them.

- Ezekiel 34:2-6 NIV
