Jesus is our Savior... who came to die to take mankind from disgrace to grace Jesus is our Example... to show us how to walk in purity, power and purpose Jesus is our Teacher... to train us in the ways of His kingdom Jesus is our Lord, King... the one we are to love, adore and obey

Great Commandment: Love God completely with all your heart, soul, mind and

strength and love your neighbor as yourself. Mark 12:29-31

Great Commission: Make disciples of all ethnic groups - Matthew 28:18-20

Jesus gave those instructions to His disciples, just before he ascended back to heaven. This was a monumental assignment, not only for them but now also for us as his disciples in another generation.

How do we fulfill His Great Commandment and His Great Commission since Jesus is no longer walking the earth? Jesus gives the answer in his parting words.

'....behold, I am with you all the days (perpetually, uniformly, and on every occasion), to the [very] close and consummation of the age. Amen (so let it be). - Matthew 28:20b Amplified Classic

When God the Father sent Jesus to this earth as the first missionary on the greatest of all missions, He was not alone. The Spirit of God was in Him right from the beginning of His earthly life. He was Born of the Spirit of God through the virgin birth. For 30 years the Holy Spirit was IN Jesus, leading and guiding Him with wisdom to live out God's perfect nature and plan. At age 30, he was Immersed in water and the Holy Spirit came upon Him. He then had God's anointing and power to do all sorts of miracles for others. -Acts 10:38. Jesus did not call them miracles but works of God. He did not take credit for them, but said that he could only do what he saw the Father doing. - John 5:17-21; 9:3-4.

Just as God sent Jesus with the Holy Spirit presence and power, Jesus has now sent us with the Spirit of God. He promised to be with us to the very end of the age, which is when he returns a second time to earth. The promise is especially relevant for those who risk their lives to spread the gospel in dangerous places. In essence, Jesus said:

I will be with you Invisibly by my Spirit until you see me visibly at my return, at the very end of the age.

Just before Jesus went to the cross to die, he poured out his heart to his disciples in a very personal way. The gospel of John, chapters 13-17, are exceptional passages to ponder as they relate to the work of the Holy Spirit. We will discuss them in another message. If we are to live by the Holy Spirit and be led my him, we must know him.

God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power, and how he sent around doing good and healing all who were under the power of the devil, because God was with him. - Acts 10:38

Who does God anoint?

- **Jesus of Nazareth** God anointed the man Jesus. Jesus later tells his disciples that anyone who has faith in him can do the miracles that he did. Jesus wanted his disciples to see that the Holy Spirit anointing is the key to walking in the supernatural. John 14:12
- God will anoint anyone who is willing to receive the Holy Spirit without reservation
- God anoints the spiritually hungry, humble and those with a servants heart.

This is what happened to Jesus' first disciples. They spread the gospel of the kingdom to their known world. They were salt and light in a dark world. Jesus calls us to the same mission. He is praying for us.
