

Doctors have served a vital purpose in society through the ages for those who seek health and healing. In primitive societies, shamans are commonly sought for healing using practices that involve spiritual entities. In our modern era, there are various types of doctors and approaches. Most doctors in the Western world practice the ABCD method. A= Allopathic (disease oriented) B= Radiation C= Cut / Surgery D= Drugs to deal with symptoms. Doctors use procedures and treatments based on what is in their medical kit. Allopathic physicians receive only a few hours of study on nutrition and natural approaches to health, besides, they are forbidden to use them in their medical practice by the Medical Boards or they could lose their license. We saw this on display during the Covid-19 pandemic. Some brave doctors who used unapproved but useful treatments such as Ivermectin or Hydroxychloroquine lost their jobs or licenses. Many countries in Africa and the largest state in India used such protocols and had very few Covid deaths. There are also Naturopaths, who use more natural means to facilitate the body in the healing process. They view the body as a whole system, rather than Allopaths, who usually only look at various parts and organs. Allopathic doctors have many specialties from which they can train more thoroughly such as Cardiologists, who need at about 14 years of study and internship after high school. All that expense and time is needed to become an expert on the heart and related issues to it. There is another doctor who is far superior to all the aforementioned medical professionals. His name is Jesus Christ. He surpasses any doctors of general medicine, specialists or integrative medicine. Jesus was known in his time as a miracle worker and supernatural healer. In some countries today he would be fined or even arrested for practicing medicine without a license. Jesus most definitely looked at persons in their totality as spirit, soul and body. He sometimes asked persons if they wanted to be made 'whole'. - John 5:6 KJV. One important criteria of a good doctor or even auto mechanic is the ability to diagnose the problem/ issue efficiently. They are often helped by diagnostic instruments that scan codes or that use X-rays and MRI scans etc. Those mechanics or doctors who are not proficient, cost the recipient more time and money as they keep trying to see if something works.

Jesus was different, as he was able to quickly discern what a person's root issues were and how to deal with them. He did not use an MRI but he used HSP, Holy Spirit Perception. If one looks at his various encounters with the sick, they will see how Jesus dealt with each one in a different way according to what the Spirit showed him.

I remember one time in London that I had to go to a doctor. As I entered his room he asked me what was wrong and I told I had something wrong in my throat. Before I even sat down in the chair in front of his desk, he was already writing a prescription for me. It seemed very impersonal and presumptuous to me, whereas Jesus treated people as special individuals and with compassion.

It would seem odd to refer to Jesus with a title to his name, eg. Rev. Jesus, Bishop Jesus, Apostle Jesus or even Dr. Jesus. I did use the M.D. behind his name in our title, but that was mainly to grab your attention. The name of Jesus represents much more than such titles. It includes the idea of one who saves, heals, delivers, liberates. The title which we mostly

know Jesus by is LORD. That reveals his sovereignty, authority, leadership and kingly role. He referred to himself as **I AM** (Greek= ego eimi) John 8:58. I AM signified that Jesus is God who is Eternal and Self-existent. This was the same word that God revealed to Moses as he was about to lead Israel out of Egypt - Exodus 3:14. However, I AM did not just mean: 'I exist' but 'I am present with you' - Exodus 3:12. God the Father and Jesus say to us: 'I am with you, to be whatever that you need me to be in your situation'.

When Jesus entered public ministry, he revealed himself as one who could bring wholeness and freedom to any person in any situation. He was the perfect radical. The word radical comes from the word 'radix' which means 'root'. While many doctors deal only with symptoms, Jesus dealt with root causes and issues. He got to the heart of matters. He was skilled in all general matters but was also a specialist in heart matters. **Jesus was a Cardiologist.** The heart was a specialty of his, as he could discern people's thoughts and motives.

Now when He was in Jerusalem at the Passover, during the feast, many believed in His name when they saw the signs which He did. But Jesus did not commit Himself to them, because He knew all men, and had no need that anyone should testify of man, for **He knew what was in man.** - John 2:23-25

But Jesus, knowing their thoughts, said, '**Why do you think evil in your hearts?**
- Matthew 9:4

We see that God first discerned evil in the heart of Lucifer.

How you have fallen from heaven, O morning star, son of the dawn! You have been cast down to the earth, you who once laid low the nations! **You said in your heart,** 'I will ascend to heaven, I will raise my throne above the stars of God; I will sit enthroned on The mount of the assembly..... - Isaiah 14:12-13

Death and Destruction lie open before the Lord - how much more **the hearts of men.**
- Proverbs 15:11

And God who knows the heart, testified to them giving them the Holy Spirit. - Acts 15:8

God knows our heart and so does the Word of God. When we read the Bible, God reveals to us the condition of our heart.

For the Word of God is living and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, It penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; **it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.** Nothing in all creation is hidden from God's sight. Everything is uncovered and laid bare before the eyes of him to whom we must give account. - Hebrews 4:12-13
